ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE ROOSEVELT DITCH COMPANY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That, we, whose names are hereunto subscribed, do under and pursuant to the general incorporation laws of the State of Idaho, associate ourselves together, for the purpose of becoming a body corporate and carrying on and conducting the business hereinafter mentioned, and doing all lawful things and acts necessary, convenient, or beneficial in regard thereto, we do hereby execute these Articles of Incorporation of the Roosevelt Ditch Company.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be

"The Roosevelt Ditch Company, Inc."

ARTICLE II

The location of the principal office and the place where the principal business of this corporation is to be transacted shall be at the City of Aberdeen, County of Bingham, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III

The purpose of this corporation and the pursuit and business which it may carry on is and shall be as follows:

To take over, hold, own, manage and control, all that part or portion of that certain canal system constructed by the Roosevelt Ditch Company or members thereof in the City of Aberdeen, County of Bingham, State of Idaho, and having its point

of diversion or headgate on the north bank of the Aberdeen-Springfield Canal Company at or near the intersection of First West Street with the main highway on the South boundary of the City of Aberdeen, said canal among other things, having been constructed for the purpose of obtaining and supplying water to the various persons who are at present or may hereafter become stockholders and members of said company, together with the laterals, headgates, flumes, water rights, rights of way, easements, franchises and all other property of every character whatsoever appertaining to that part or portion of said system that has been or may hereafter be conveyed to the purchasers of water rights thereunder, as provided by law and as set forth in the certain several contracts of purchase, which convey or agree to convey to each several purchaser, a proportionate interest in such system based upon the number of shares of water rights finally sold therein. The object and purpose hereof being to create a holding corporation to take over, acquire, hold, control, manage, reconstruct and maintain the said system belonging to or in any wise necessary or appurtenant to the interests of said purchasers and water users, and this corporation, in addition to all the powers conferred upon it by virtue of the general incorporation laws, shall have the right to take over, own, hold, control, manage and maintain said system, to acquire by purchase, gift or any other lawful manner, any and all kinds of property, whether real, personal or mixed, that may in any wise be necessary or convenient to enable it to carry out the purpose for which it is organized;

to extend said system and acquire additional water rights, rights of way, franchises and easements, to fix charges, rentals, and tolls, to regulate and distribute water to the several users under said system according to their respective rights, and for the purpose of defraying the cost of maintenance, operation, and extention of said system and carrying out the purpose of this corporation in supplying to its users the water required and appurtenant to said lands in the most practical and economical manner and to do any and all things that may be needful to protect the users of water under this system and secure the greatest beneficial use of said water to said lands, and it shall have the power to levy fixed charges and assessments ratably and according to the benefits derived, against said lands, and to collect from its stockholders and all persons entitled to use water through said system, the expense of delivering the water upon such lands, to collect tolls, rentals, assessments and maintenance charges based upon the number of shares of each stockholder, and the right to defray any and all lawful expenses incident to the maintenance or operating of said Ditch System and for necessary and proper betterments, and for these and all other necessary or proper purposes, it may borrow money, execute corporate obligations and secure the same by proper Deeds of Trust.

ARTICLE IV

The term for which this corporation is to exist is Fifty

Years from and after the filing of these Article of Incorporation, unless sooner disincorporated according to law.

ARTICLE V

That the Board of Directors shall have the management of the business and property of this corporation and such other management and control as may be prescribed by the constitution and by-laws of this corporation. The names and residences of these who were elected to the Board of Directors at the 1954 annual meeting and until their successors are elected and oualified, are as follows:
