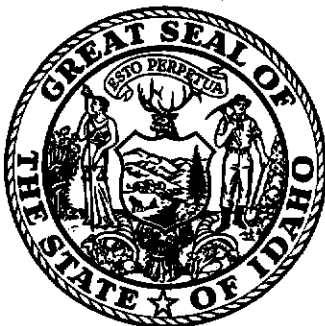

RESOLUTION.

~~Thereupon~~ the following resolution was introduced by
Commissioner J. P. Bischoff and read for the consideration
of the board, to wit:-

Whereas, on the 13th day of July, 1914, there was presented to the clerk of the board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Idaho, a petition, purporting to be signed by a majority of the taxable inhabitants of the proposed Village of Dayton, Franklin County, Idaho, and not heretofore incorporated under any law of this state, said petition praying that petitioners may be incorporated as a village, and designating "The Village of Dayton" as the name petitioners wish to assume, and setting forth the metes and bounds of the proposed village, which said petition is in words and figures as follows, to wit:-

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
FRANKLIN COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO:-

We the undersigned, constituting a majority of the taxable
inhabitants within the metes and bounds of the proposed Village of
Dayton, in Franklin County, State of Idaho, and which is not nor has
it been heretofore incorporated under any law of this State;

Do present, hereby, this petition to the Board of County
Commissioners of said Franklin County, State of Idaho, in which pro-
posed village, and in which county and state, we, the said petitioners,
reside, And we do hereby pray that we may be incorporated as a village,
hereby designating the name we wish to assume to be ~~the~~ "The-Dayton
"THE VILLAGE OF DAYTON", and we further hereby designate the boundary of
the proposed Village of Dayton by metes and bounds as follows, to wit:-

Beginning at the South-East corner of the North-East quarter
($\frac{1}{4}$) of section 26, running thence West $1\frac{3}{8}$ miles to the South-West cor-
ner of the South-East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the South-West quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the
North-East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section 27, thence running North 3 miles to the
South-West corner of the South-East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the South-West $\frac{1}{4}$
quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the North-East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section 10; thence running
East $1\frac{3}{8}$ miles to the South-East corner of the North-East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$)
of section 11; thence running South 3 miles to place of beginning; all
in Township fifteen (15) South, Range 38 East Boise Meridian; and
all situated in the county of Franklin and state of Idaho.

We further hereby represent and certify that inhabitants to the number of more than two hundred (200) are actual residents of the territory described in this petition for the proposed village of Dayton.

And whereas, the said board of county commissioners of said county are satisfied that a majority of the taxable inhabitants of said proposed village have signed such petition, and that inhabitants to the number of two hundred (200) or more are actual residents of the territory described in the petition:-Now therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED:-

(1) That the petition of a majority of the taxable inhabitants of the proposed village of Dayton, above referred to, in the county of Franklin, State of Idaho, which said village has not heretofore been incorporated under any law of this state, has been in full conformity with law of this state presented to the county commissioners of Franklin County, Idaho, in which said petitioners reside, praying that they may be incorporated as a village and designated as "THE VILLAGE OF DAYTON" have signed as the name they wish to assume, and designating the metes and bounds of the proposed village.

(2) That the board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Idaho, are satisfied, and hereby find and certify, that a majority of the taxable inhabitants of the proposed Village of Dayton have signed such petition, and that inhabitants to the number of two hundred (200) or more are actual residents of the territory described in the petition.

(3) That the board of county commissioners of said Franklin county, Idaho, do hereby declare the said proposed village incorporated, hereby entering the order of incorporation upon their minutes records, declaring the corporate name of the said Village to be "The Village of Dayton" in the county of Franklin, State of Idaho.

(4) The metes and bounds of the said village of Dayton are hereby designated as follows, to wit:-

Beginning at the South-East corner of the North-East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section 26, running thence West $1\frac{3}{8}$ miles to the South-West corner of the South-East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the South-West quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the North-East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section 27, thence running North 3 miles to the South-West corner of the South-East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the South-West quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the North-East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section 10; thence running East $1\frac{3}{8}$ miles to the South-East corner of the North-East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section 11; thence running South 3 miles to the place of beginning; all in Township fifteen (15) South, Range 38 East Boise M Meridian; and all situated in the county of Franklin and State of Idaho.

(5) That from and after the date of this order, the said village of Dayton shall be and is hereby declared to be, a body corporate, and shall be governed by the provisions of Title 13 of the Idaho Revised Codes and such other sections and provisions of said Code applicable to the government of villages.

(6) That the following five persons having the qualifications provided by law in section 2224 of the Idaho Revised Codes, be and they are hereby appointed as trustees of said village of Dayton, and said trustees of said shall hold their offices and perform all the duties required of them by law until the election and qualification of their successors at the time and place in the manner provided by law, said persons are, to wit:-

Commissioner J. P. Bischoff seconded the motion.

The question being upon the adoption of the resolution and the entering of said order, the roll was called, with the following result:-

The chairman thereupon declared that all of the commissioners having voted unanimously in favor of said order and resolution, the motion was carried and said resolution adopted and said order entered.

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners,
Franklin County, Idaho,
Gentlemen:-

We the undersigned respectfully represent to your honorable body that at a mass meeting ~~ea~~ held at Dayton, Idaho, June 30 1914, we the undersigned acted respectively in the positions of Chairman and Secretary, that the purpose of said meeting was to learn the choice of the people of ~~Da~~ the proposed Village of Dayton. Dayton to act as the board of trustees of the said Village of Dayton, provided your honorable body see fit to so incorporate said territory into a village, that in accordance with said purpose the following men were chosen ~~as-the~~ by ballot and resolution as the men to be recommended to you for appointment, they are Joseph Hansen, James P. Scow, James Page, D.W. Butters, and Charles Jones.

We therefore ask in behalf of the people and taxpayers that of Dayton ~~the~~ said men be appointed by you as said trustees in the event that you create a village of said territory as above referred to.
