CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

METHODIST CHURCH OF ATHOL, IDAHO, INCORPORATED

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Sixth** day of **July**, A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-four** and is duly recorded on Film No. **129** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Athol** in the County of **Kootenai** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
METHODIST CHURCH OF ATHOL, IDAHO

We the undersigned, being natural persons over the age of twenty-one years of age and residents of Kootenai County, Idaho, and citizens of the United States of America, and members of the Methodist Church, Athol, Idaho, in accordance with the discipline of the Methodist Church, for the purpose of doing all acts which are required by said discipline and the usages of said church to be done and performed by the trustees of the said church, desiring to incorporate such church and to form ourselves into a corporation and body politic under the laws of the State of Idaho for the use and benefit of said Methodist Church at Athol, Kootenai County, Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under Chapter II, Title 30, of the Idaho Code entitled "Religious, Societies and Benevolent Corporations", and adopted the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation shall be METHODIST CHURCH OF ATHOL, IDAHO, INCORPORATED.

ARTICLE II.

The object and purpose of the organization of this corporation is to enable said Church, through her said Trustees, to have the power to acquire, hold, sell, and convey property, both real and personal, and continue and perform all other matters necessary to the management of said Methodist Church at Athol, Kootenai County, Idaho, according to the provisions of the discipline and the usages and the ministerial appointments of the Methodist Church of the United States of America as from time to time authorized and directed by the General Conference of said Church

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and the annual Conference within whose bounds such corporation is situated.

ARTICLE III.

The existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV.

The registered office and place at which the principal business of this corporation shall be conducted and transacted shall be located in the Village of Athol, Kootenai County, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE V.

This corporation shall have no capital stock. The terms of admission to membership in the corporation shall be as prescribed by the discipline of the Methodist Church of the United States of America.

ARTICLE VI.

The business of this corporation shall be conducted by a Board of Trustees of not less than three or more than nine persons, each of whom shall be not less than twenty-one years of age, and two-thirds of whom shall be members of the Methodist Church of the circuit or station in which Athol, Idaho is situated, and the majority of whom shall be necessary to transact business.

ARTICLE VII.

That the Board of Trustees shall be elected annually by the Fourth Quarterly Conference of the circuit or station of the Methodist Church in which Athol, Kootenai County, Idaho, may be situated. In event of a failure to elect at the proper time, a subsequent quarterly conference may elect, provided that all Trustees may hold their offices until their successors are elected.

ARTICLE VIII.

The Board of Trustees shall be governed in the management of the affairs of the body politic by the discipline and usage of the Methodist Church of the United States of America, and by the laws of the land.
