

ARTICLES - OF - INCORPORATION

SUGAR CITY LUMBER COMPANY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation, under the laws of the State of Idaho.

AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

First. That the name of said corporation is, SUGAR CITY LUMBER COMPANY, and is to be a limited corporation.

Second. That the purposes for which it is formed, are, to on carry the business of Manufacturing, Buying and Selling all kinds of Building Material; the owning and operating of Saw Mills, Shingle Mills, Planing Mills, and other mills for the manufacture of timber for trade and commerce;; The owning and acquiring of timber and Timber lands; the buying and selling of Farming Implements and Farming Machinery; the acquiring and operating of General Merchandise Stores for trade and commerce; the buying and selling of Farm Products, Live-Stock, Coal and other kinds of Fuel, and the doing of all things necessary for the carrying into effect of the aforementioned purposes of said corporation.

Third. That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be Sugar City, Fremont County, State of Idaho.

Fourth. That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.
