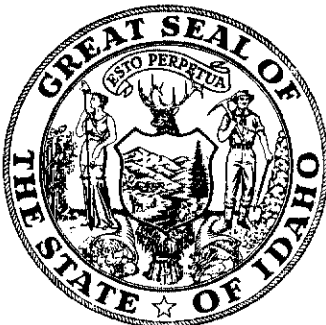

Dear Ms. Haken:

On February 20, 1994 a vote was taken of the Session of the Community Presbyterian Church of St. Maries, Idaho. At that time the 12 Elders of our church and our pastor voted unanimously to file for an Article of Amendment as per Section 30-3-93 of the Idaho Code. our church has approximately 200 members. As stated in our church By-Laws Article III Section 1, our Session, composed of 12 members of our congregation, has administrative responsibility for both corporate and spiritual decisions within our church.

It was further unanimously agreed to that we wanted this Article of Amendment to extend our Corporation status into perpetuity. The exact question put forth to the Session was as follows: "Our corporation status expired on 11/3/93. On behalf of the Community Presbyterian Church do you wish to file an Article of Amendment to extend our corporation status into perpetuity? "
