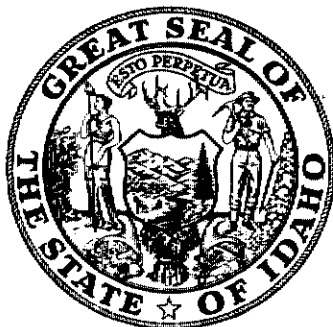
### CERTIFICATE OF DISSOLUTION OF

ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION SECRETARY OF STATE

Upon execution by all of its shareholders of a Consent to Voluntary Dissolution of Lake Plantation Properties, Inc. therein indicating the authority of said shareholders to dissolve Lake Plantation Properties, Inc., the officers of said corporation hereby declare as follows:

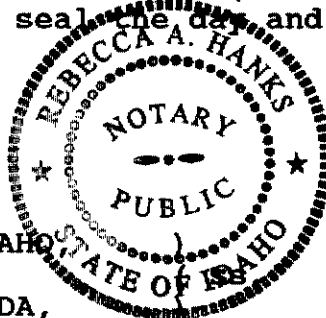

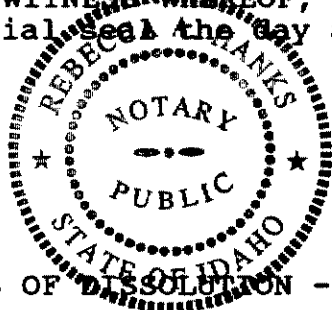

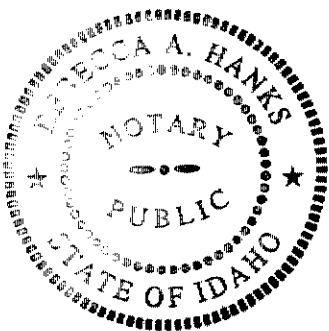
