EXHIBIT "A"

Article 5 of the Articles of Incorporation of Banbury Meadows Homeowners Association, Inc., filed with the Idaho Secretary of State on March 19, 1999, is hereby amended and vested in its entirety to read as follows:

Article 5. <u>Voting Rights</u>: The corporation shall have two classes of voting membership.

CLASS A. Class A members shall be all Owners, with the exception of the Declarant, and shall be entitled to one vote for each lot owned. When more than one person holds an interest in any lot, all such persons shall be members. The vote for such lot shall be exercised as they determine, but in no event shall more than one vote be cast with respect to any lot. Fractional votes shall not be allowed. The vote applicable to any said lot being sold under contract of purchase shall be exercised by the contract seller, unless the contract expressly provides otherwise.

<u>CLASS B</u>. Class B member(s) shall be the Declarant as defined in the Declaration, and shall be entitled to ten (10) votes for each lot owned. The Class B membership shall cease and be converted to Class A membership on the happening of either of the following events, whichever occurs first:

- (a) When the total votes outstanding in the Class A membership equal the total votes outstanding in the Class B membership, or
- (b) On June 1, 2010.
