ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

BOISE BOYS BASEBALL, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, all being full-age citizens and residents of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated curselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit under the laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this corporation shall be Boise Boys Baseball, Inc.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSES

The purposes for which this corporation is to be formed are:

- (a) The furtherance of the game of baseball amoung the youth of the City of Boise, Boise Valley and adjacent areas.
- (b) To occupy the youth of the above aforesaid areas in an athletic activity to develop the physical strength of their bodies and the mental processes of their minds in a sportsmanlike manner.
- (c) To develop discipline in training and playing baseball according to the dictates of good sportsmanship.
 - (d) To develop teams and leagues for the playing of baseball.
- (e) And lastly, to instill in the youth the principals of good sports-manship.

ARTICLE III

DURATION

The period of existence and duration of life of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

PLACE OF BUSINESS

The location and post office address of the registered office of this corporation in the State of Idaho, shall be 605 Vista Avenue, Boise, Ada County, Idaho.

ARTICLE V

NON PROFIT

The corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit nor shall it have any power to issue certificates of stock or declare dividends, and no part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any member, director, or individual.

The balance, if any, of all money received by the corporation from its operations, after the payment in full of all debts and obligations of the corporation of whatsoever kind and nature, shall be used and distributed exclusively for physical development of youth and for charitable, scientific, and education purposes.

ARTICLE VI

MEMBERSHIP

The corporation shall issue membership certificates to its members, the method and conditions of membership and the issuance and transfer of membership certificates to be determined by the Board of Directors as provided in the By-Laws of the corporation. All the rights and interests of all members shall be equal, and no member can have or acquire a greater interest therein than any other member.

ARTICLE VII

OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

The general officers of said corporation shall be a President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer and such other officers as may be determined by the Board of Directors. The number of the Board of Directors shall be at least five (5) persons and such additional number as may be determined by the membership of the corporation at its annual meeting.

ARTICLE VIII

ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

The officers shall be elected by the Directors, who shall first be elected by the members of said corporation.

ARTICLE IX

CONDITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP

The method and conditions upon which members shall be accepted and

discharged or expelled shall be as provided in the By-Laws of this corporation.

ARTICLE X

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These articles may be amended in the manner provided by statute at the time of amendment.
