

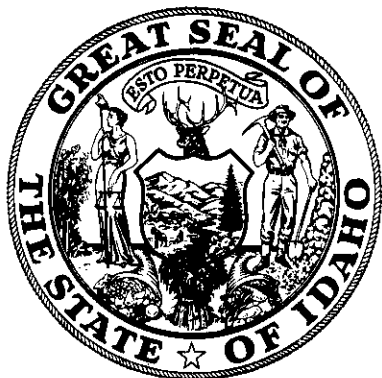
CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We, the undersigned natural persons all being the age of eighteen or more, acting as incorporators under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopt the following articles of incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE ONE NAME

The name of the corporation shall be

MORMON HANDICRAFT INCORPORATED.

ARTICLE TWO DURATION

The corporation shall have a perpetual existence.

ARTICLE THREE PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized are as follows:

1. To engage in the business of merchandising handicraft items and-to engage in all other business related thereto.
2. To purchase, to receive by way of gift, subscribe for, invest in, and in all other ways acquire, import, lease, possess, maintain, handle on consignment, own, hold for investment or otherwise use, enjoy, exercise, operate, manage, conduct, perform, make borrow, guarantee, contract

in respect of, trade and deal in, sell, exchange, let, lend, export, mortgage, pledge, deed in trust, hypothecate, encumber, transfer, assign and in all other ways dispose of, design, develop, invent, improve, equip, repair, alter, fabricate, assemble, build, construct, operate, manufacture, plant, cultivate, produce, market, and in all other ways (whether like or unlike any of the foregoing), deal in and with property of every kind and character, real, personal or mixed, tangible or intangible, wherever situated and however held, including, but not limited to, money, credits, choses in action, securities, stocks, bonds, warrants, script, certificates, debentures, mortgages, notes, commercial paper and other obligations and evidences of interest in or indebtedness of any person, firm or corporation, foreign or domestic, or of any government or subdivision or agency thereof, documents of title, and accompanying rights, and every other kind and character of personal property, real property (improved or unimproved), and the products and avails thereof, and every character of interest therein and appurtenance thereto, including but not limited to, mineral, oil, gas and water rights, all or any part of any going business and its incidents, franchises, subsidies, charters, concessions, grants, rights, powers or privileges, granted or conferred by any government or subdivision or agency thereof, and interest in or part of any of the foregoing, and to exercise in respect thereof all of the rights, powers, privileges, and immunities of individual owners or

holders thereof.

3. To hire and employ agents, servants and employees, and to enter into agreements of employment and collective bargaining agreements, and to act as agent, contractor, trustee, factor or otherwise, either alone or in company with others.

4. To promote or aid in any manner, financially or otherwise, any person, firm association or corporation, and to guarantee contracts and other obligations.

5. To let concessions to others to do any of the things that this corporation is empowered to do, and to enter into, make, perform and carry out, contracts, and arrangements of every kind and character with any person, firm, association or corporation, or any government or authority or subdivision or agency thereof.

6. To carry on any business whatsoever that this corporation may deem proper or convenient in connection with any of the foregoing purposes or otherwise, or that it may deem calculated, directly or indirectly, to improve the interests of this corporation, and to do all things specified in the Idaho Business Corporation Act, and to have and to exercise all powers conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho on corporations formed under the laws

pursuant to which and under which this corporation is formed, as such laws are now in effect or may at any time hereafter be amended, and to do any and all things set forth above to the same extent and as fully as natural persons might or could do, either alone or in connection with other persons, firms, associations or corporations, and in any part of the world.

The foregoing statement of purposes shall be liberally construed as a statement of both purposes and powers, shall be liberally construed in aid of the powers of this corporation, and the powers of this corporation, and the powers and purposes stated in each clause shall, except where otherwise stated, be in nowise limited or restricted by any term or provision of any other clause, and shall be regarded not only as independent purposes, but the purposes and powers stated in each clause shall, except where otherwise stated, be in nowise limited or restricted by any term or provision of any other clause, and shall be regarded not only as independent purposes, but the purposes and powers stated shall be construed distributively as each object expressed, and enumeration as to specific powers shall not be construed as to limit in any manner the aforesaid general powers, but are in furtherance of, and in addition to and not in limitation of said general powers.

ARTICLE FOUR CAPITALIZATION

The total number of shares of stock which the corporation has authority to issue is 50,000 shares, with a par value of \$1 (one dollar), all of one class.

The corporation shall at no time make any offering of its stock, which offering would constitute a public offering under the Securities Act of 1933 and any amendments thereto, or under any applicable statutes of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE FIVE COMMENCING BUSINESS

The corporation will not commence business until consideration of the value of at least One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) has been received for the issuance of shares.

ARTICLE SIX REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

The address of the corporation's initial registered office shall be 4619 Hawthorne Rd, Chubbuck, Idaho 83202.

The corporation's initial registered agent at such address shall be Carol Lynn McIntosh.

ARTICLE SEVEN DIRECTORS
