ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

RANCHERS, INC.

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, JAMES A. WARNER, LORNA A. COSTELLO and MARY LOU TROYER, each being a natural person of full age, and a citizen of the United States of America, have voluntarily and do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify, declare and adopt the following articles of incorporation:

I.

The name of this corporation shall be RANCHERS, INC.

II.

The period of existence and duration of the life of this corporation shall be perpetual.

III.

The location of the registered office of this corporation shall be 5010 Franklin Road, Boise, Idaho, and the address of the registered office of this corporation shall be 5010 Franklin Road, Boise, County of Ada, State of Idaho.

IV.

The nature of the business and the objects and purposes of this corporation shall be:

1. To transact an investment and loan business with power

to loan money without security or to loan money with security upon real estate, chattels and personal securities.

- 2. To purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, sell, assign, endorse, transfer, mortgage, pledge, hypothecate, or otherwise dispose of and to deal generally in notes, bonds, contracts, stocks, warrants, bills, open accounts, and other evidences of indebtedness of individuals, firms, partnerships and corporations, municipal, public and private, except as limited by law; to loan its funds, with or without security, on notes, open accounts or otherwise.
- 3. To purchase, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire and own, hold, use, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge, exchange or otherwise dispose of real and personal property of every kind and description, including but not limited to shares of stock, bonds, debentures, notes, evidences of indebtedness, and other securities, contracts or obligations of any corporation or corporations, association or associations, domestic or foreign, and to pay therefor in whole or in part in cash or by exchanging therefor stocks, bonds, or other evidences of indebtedness or securities of this or any other corporation, and while the owner or holder of any such real or personal property, stocks, bonds, debentures, notes, evidences of indebtedness or other securities, contracts or obligations to receive, collect, and dispose of the interest, dividends and income arising from such property, and to possess and exercise in respect thereof, all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including all voting powers on any stocks so owned.
- 4. To deal and traffic real estate and all estates and interests therein, whether owned by it or otherwise; to buy, take, lease, rent, option, or in any other manner acquire, own, hold, possess, sell,

exchange, lease, convey, transfer, rent, mortgage, give liens against, or in any other manner dispose of or encumber real estate, and any and all interests or estates therein, whether within or without the State of Idaho, including water and irrigation rights and irrigation and/or drain ditches, whether classified as real or personal property.

- 5. To lay out, subdivide and/or plat real estate in lots, blocks, subdivisions, townsites, or otherwise to dedicate and establish streets, alleys, parks and public grounds, and to build, repair, remodel, construct, acquire, hold and equip, houses, buildings, roads, streets, sidewalks, fences, pavements, sewers and ditches, conduits, reservoirs, waterworks, irrigation systems and in any other manner improve, use, maintain, operate and/or develop real estate for any purpose or use, whether owned byit or otherwise; and to contract to do any of said acts for others.
- 6. To purchase, hold, sell and transfer the shares of its own capital stock; provided it shall not use its funds or property for the purchase of its own shares of capital stock when such use would cause any impairment of its capital; and provided further that shares of its own capital stock belonging to it shall not be voted upon directly or indirectly.
- 7. To enter into, make and perform and carry out contracts of every sort and kind with any person, firm, association or corporation, municipality, body politic, country, territory, district, states, and government.
- 8. To institute, enter into, carry on, assist, promote or participate in financial, commercial, mercantile, industrial and other businesses, works, enterprises, undertakings and operations.
 - 9. In the purchase or acquisition of property, business, rights

or franchises, or for additional working capital, or for any other object in or about its business or affairs, and without limit as to amount, to incur debt, and to raise, borrow, and secure the payment of money in any lawful manner, including the issue and sale or other disposition of bonds, debentures, obligations, negotiable and transferrable instruments and evidences of indebtedness of all kinds, whether secured by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust or otherwise.

- 10. To carry on any other business, which may seem to the corporation capable of being conveniently carried on in connection with its business or calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of or render profitable any of the corporation's property or rights.
- 11. The said corporation may perform any part of its business outside the State of Idaho, in the other states, in the District of Columbia, territories or possessions, or dependencies of the United States.
- 12. To do each and everything suitable, necessary, useful or advisable for the accomplishment of any one or more of said objects, or which shall, at any time appear to be conducive to or expedient for the benefit of said corporation in connection therewith.
- 13. To do each and all things set forth herein to the same extent and as fully as natural persons might do or could do in the State of Idaho, and in any other state, country or place.
- 14. To have one or more offices, to carry on all or any of its operations and business and without restriction or limit as to amount, to purchase, or otherwise acquire, to hold, own, to mortgage, sell, convey, or otherwise dispose of real and personal property of every class and description in any of the states, districts, territories, dependencies, possessions or colonies of the United States.

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15. The foregoing clauses shall be construed as objects, purposes and powers; and it is hereby expressly provided that any enumeration of specific powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of this corporation.

16. In general, to carry on any other business in connection with the foregoing, and to have and exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of Idaho upon corporations.

V.

In furtherance, and not in limitation of the powers conferred by statute, the board of directors is expressly authorized:

- 1. To make and alter by-laws of this corporation, to fix the amount to be reserved as working capital over and above its capital stock paid in, and to authorize and cause to be executed mortgages and liens upon the real and personal property of this corporation.
- 2. If the by-laws so provided, to designate two or more of its members to constitute an executive committee, which committee shall for the time being, as provided in said resolution or in the by-laws of this corporation, have and exercise any or all of the powers of the board of directors in the management of the business and affairs of the corporation, and have power to authorize the seal of this corporation to be affixed to all papers which may require it.
- 3. Pursuant to the affirmative vote of the holders of at least a majority of the stock issued and outstanding, having voting power, given at a stockholders' meeting duly called for that purpose, or when authorized by the written consent of at least a majority of the holders of the voting stock issued and outstanding, the board of directors shall have power and authority at any meeting to sell, lease or exchange all of the property and assets of this corporation, including its good will and its

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corporate franchises, upon such terms and conditions as its board of directors deem expedient and for the best interest of the corporation.

4. This corporation may in its by-laws confer powers upon its directors in addition to the foregoing, and in addition to the powers and authorities expressly conferred upon them by statute.

VI.

The capital stock of this corporation shall be \$100,000.00, divided into 10,000 shares of the par value of \$10.00 each. No distinction shall exist between the shares of this corporation and all such shares shall have the same rights in the corporation.

VЦ.

All or any portion of the capital stock may be issued for cash or in payment for real or personal property, services, or any other right or thing of value, for the uses and purposes of the corporation, and when so issued shall become and be fully paid, the same as though paid for in cash at par; and the directors shall be the sole judges of the value of any property, right or thing acquired in exchange for capital stock.

VIII.

From time to time the capital stock may be increased according to law, and may be issued in such amounts and proportions as shall be determined by the board of directors, and as may be permitted by law.

IX.

The private property of the stockholders shall not be subject to the payment of corporate debts to any extent whatsoever.

X.

The business of the corporation shall be managed and conducted

by a board of directors of not less than three members nor more than five. The first board shall consist of three members and may be raised up to four or five at any time by a majority vote of the stockholders. The first board shall be elected at the first meeting of the stockholders of this corporation and the entire board to be elected annually thereafter at the annual meeting of the stockholders of the corporation. The board of directors may meet and transact the business of the corporation whether at its principal place of business herein designated or at such other place within or without the State of Idaho as may be designated by resolution of the board. A director need not be a stockholder of the corporation.

XI.

That the holders of stock of this corporation shall not have the right upon sale of further stock by the corporation to pre-emptive rights as provided by Idaho Code, Section 30-120, subsection 6.

XII.
