ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

MULTI-PIX OF IDAHO, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all being of full age and citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we hereby certify in writing:

I.

That the name of said corporation shall be "MULTI-PIX OF IDAHO, INC.

II.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

(1) To engage in the business of furnishing television antenna and co-axial cable service to others, and generally to engage in all phases of the television and electronics business.

(2) To purchase, lease, construct, install, erect, string, stretch, maintain and operate a television antenna and co-axial cable service within and without the State of Idaho, over, across, along and under streets, alleys, bridges and public and private places within and without the State of Idaho.

(3) To apply for and to join with others in applying for and securing licenses, franchises and other indications of approval of state, federal and local governmental agencies for the operation of a television antenna and co-axial cable service.

(4) To design, manufacture, install, purchase, or otherwise acquire, to sell or otherwise dispose of, and to generally deal in and with electric transmitting and receiving sets, wired and wireless telegraph and telephone instruments and apparatus and devices used or useful in connection with the transmission of images, animate and inanimate, by electrical means for visualization at places distant from the place where such images are primarily perceived.

(5) To purchase, lease, own, sell, mortgage, sublease, or otherwise acquire or dispose of lands, buildings, easements or property both real and personal, and to enter into, ~~make~~, perform and carry out contracts of every sort and kind with any person, and to acquire and take over the good will, property, rights, franchises, options and assets of every kind and the liabilities of any person, firm, or corporation, either wholly or in part, and to pay for the same in cash, stocks, or bonds of the corporation or otherwise.

(6) To purchase or acquire property, business rights or franchises or for any other object in or about its business affairs, to incur debt and to borrow and secure the payment of money in any lawful manner, including the issue and sale or other disposition of bonds, debentures, notes or other evidence of indebtedness, and to acquire by purchase, gift, or otherwise, shares of its own corporate stock and cancel the same for resale as treasury stock, or for the purpose of making stock dividends to its shareholders, and to restrict the transferability of its outstanding shares to the extent reasonably necessary to protect the rights of the corporation and its shareholders in any stock purchase, contracts, or options that may be made between themselves or any of them.

(7) To act as surety or creditor in any and all types of engagement including the power to execute, endorse and deliver contracts and to guarantee prompt and faithful performance of any other person, firm, partnership or corporation, and to act as accommodation co-maker or guarantor on obligations either as primary or secondary obligor.

(8) Without in any manner limiting any of the objects, purposes or powers of the corporation, the business or purposes of said corporation shall be from time to time to do any one or more or all of the acts or things herein set forth.

(9) The several subdivisions contained in this paragraph of purposes shall be construed as both purposes and powers and the enumeration thereof shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers conferred on business corporations by the laws of the State of Idaho, all of which powers are hereby expressly claimed.

III.

That the corporation shall have perpetual existence.

IV.

That the registered office and principal place of business of said corporation in the State of Idaho shall be located in Burley, in the County of Cassia, and that the post office address of the registered office of said corporation in the State of Idaho is Burley, Idaho.

V.

That the amount of capital stock of said corporation shall be composed entirely of stock of no par value and the authorized number of such shares of no par stock shall be Fifty (50). That all of said stock shall be known as common stock and shall be non-assessable.

VI.

That the amount of capital stock of said corporation which has been actually subscribed is three shares, and the
