1                   ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

3                   BOISE CLEANERS, INC.

4                   KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned  
5                   each of whom is a bona fide resident and citizen of the State of  
6                   Idaho, and the United States of America, and each of whom is a  
7                   natural person of full age, have this day voluntarily associated  
8                   ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under  
9                   the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

10                  ARTICLE I

11                  That the name of this corporation shall be:

12                  BOISE CLEANERS, INC.

13                  ARTICLE II

14                  The objects and purposes for which this corporation is  
15                  formed are: As principal, agent, or otherwise to do in any part  
16                  of the world any and every of the things herein set forth to the  
17                  same extent as natural persons might or could do. In furtherance,  
18                  and not in limitation, of the general powers, conferred by the  
19                  laws of the State of Idaho, we do expressly provide that the corpora-  
20                  tion shall have power:

21                  (a) To clean, dye, press, plait, alter, and repair  
22                  wearing apparel and clothing of every kind and description; to  
23                  do a general cleaning, dyeing, pressing, plaiting, and tailoring  
24                  business.

25                  To buy and sell cloth, trimmings, and all materials and  
26                  products necessary for a general cleaning, dyeing, pressing, plaiting,  
27                  or tailoring business.

28                  To clean, dye, and repair carpets, rugs, furs, leather  
29                  goods, and all other household products.

30                  (b) To operate cleaning establishments, stores, and  
31                  places of business of all kinds and descriptions.

1                         (c) To enter into, make, perform, and carry out contracts  
2 of every kind, amount, and character with any person, firm, associa-  
3 tion or corporation.

4                         (d) To purchase, own, sell, convey, mortgage, pledge,  
5 exchange, acquire by operation of law or otherwise, real property,  
6 of every kind and character, and each and every kind of personal  
7 property, debts, dues, and demands or choses of action, evidence  
8 of debts, bonds, stocks of corporations, both public and private.

9                         (e) To borrow ~~and~~ and lend money from and to any person,  
10 firm, association, and to make, take and execute notes, mortgages,  
11 bonds, deeds of trust, or other evidence of indebtedness, to secure  
12 payment thereof, or by any other lawful manner or means, and to  
13 take and receive notes, bonds, mortgages, deeds of trust, or any  
14 evidence of indebtedness, for the use and benefit of said corpora-  
15 tion or otherwise.

16                         (f) To own, hold, lease or sublet, or to conduct on its  
17 own account, or for any person, firm, association or corporation,  
18 all and every kind of merchandise.

19                         (g) To build any and all necessary shops, buildings,  
20 warehouses and structures at any place proper or convenient to  
21 carry on any or all of the business of said corporation.

22                         (h) To purchase or otherwise acquire and own the cor-  
23 porate common and preferred stock and bonds of any other corporation,  
24 and also to purchase and acquire its own common stock in so far  
25 as not contrary to the laws of the State of Idaho.

26                         (i) In addition to the foregoing powers, also to have  
27 all authority, powers, and rights granted by the laws of the State  
28 of Idaho, and particularly Section 30-114, Idaho Code, and any  
29 amendments thereto.

30                         (j) In general to transact and do all such matters  
31 and things as are or shall be considered as conducive or incidental  
32 to each and every of the above purposes, and to conduct and carry  
on the business for which this corporation is organized alone.

1 and/or with others as co-partners or joint adventurers or otherwise,  
2 it being expressly provided that the foregoing enumeration of  
3 specific powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any  
4 manner the general powers of the corporation.

5    ARTICLE III

6    The registered office of this corporation and the prin-  
7 cipal place for transaction of its business is hereby designated  
8 as Boise, Ada County, Idaho.

9    ARTICLE IV.

10   This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

11    ARTICLE V

12    The number of directors of this corporation shall be not  
13 less than five (5) in number.

14    ARTICLE VI

15    The amount of the capital stock of this corporation is  
16 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) divided into Five Hundred  
17 Shares of common stock, each of the par value of One Hundred Dollars  
18 (\$100.00) per share, and said stock shall be non-assessable.

19    ARTICLE VII

20    The amount of the capital stock actually subscribed is  
21 five shares by the persons whose residence and the amounts sub-  
22 scribed herein are set forth:


