ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CUSTOM TRANSMISSION, INC.

The undersigned persons, acting as the incorporators of a corporation organized under and pursuant to the Idaho Business Corporation Act, Chapter 1, Title 30 of the Idaho Code, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I

Name. The Name of the Corporation is Custom Transmission, Inc..
