I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

CONGREGATION OF JEHOVAH'S WITNESSES, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Twenty-third** day of **April**, A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-four** and is duly recorded on Film No. **128** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101

and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for perpetual existence from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at St. Maries in the County of Benevah and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION-OF,

ST. MARIES, IDAHO, CONGREGATION OF JEHOVAH'S WITNESSES, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, three undersigned servants and members of the unincorporated congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses of Benewah County of St. Maries, State of Idaho, for the purpose of incorporating the same pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho and all being of adult age and citizens of the United States and the State of Idaho do hereby certify and adopt the following articles of incorporation:

ARTICLES I

The Objects and presesed Corporation shall be,

CONGREGATION OF JEHOVAH'S WITNESSES, INC. And its location and its post office address and registered office in this state is 130 College Ave. St Maries, Idaho, and the same is its principal place of business.

ARTICLE II

The object and purpose of this corporation are to buy, build, erect, alter, operate and maintain any and all and classes of real and personal property nessary for the business and objects of this corporation; To issue bonds, notes, contracts, debenture warrants, checks, mortgages, deeds and bills of sale on corporation property and/or credit, and to hold, sell or lawfully dispose of the same to promote the purposes of this corporation; To act as a ministerial and legal organization under the direction of the Watchtower Bible & Tract Society, Inc.; 117 Adams StreetBrooklyn 1, New York; To distribute Bibles, Bible aids, religious literature published by the said Wathhtower Society; To buy, sell encumber r, trade, hold, lease, own, and rent both real and personal property for the purposes here in mentioned; To provide and maintain homes, halls, buildings, and places, for the housing, meeting places, and public address es of christaian students, missionaries, lecturers and teachers under the direction at all times of the Watchtower Bible & Tract Society, Inc. To arrange for and hold local assemblies for public Christian worship; To arrange-for-end use and operate radio stations, newspapers, and all other media for the dissemination of bible truths; To do any and all other things necessary and proper for the attainment and fulfillment of the above objects and purposes; To maintain, own and have a place of religious worship.

ARTICLE III

This corporation is to be a non-profit religious and church organization only, and no stock shall be issued and no dividends or pecuniary profits shall be declared to the members thereof.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation shall have propertual existance from and after the date of this corporation.

ARTICLE V

That on the 10 day of April 1964 at the Kingdom Hall, of Jehovah's Witnesses, an election was held at which time a majority of the members of the unincorporated congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses of St. Maries, Idaho, were present and did vote for the following three members to be directors of this proposed corporation, namely:

History Birgland Bill St Manie Land

And that said three members were elected by unanimous vote of al members present; that prior to said election and meeting, notice of said meeting and election was duly given as required by law by publication of notice in the GAZETTE RECORD, a newspaper printed and distributed in St. Maries, Idaho and future notice was given by and posting of said notice on the door of the said Kingdom Hall, Of Jehovah's Witnesses, In St. Maries, Idaho, for a period of three weeks.
