KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the undersigned, in order to form a professional service corporation for the purpose hereinafter stated, pursuant to the Idaho Professional Services Act, does hereby adopt the following articles of incorporation, to-wit:

I

NAME

The name of this corporation shall be Van Orden Veterinary Services, P.A.

II

PURPOSE

The purpose for which this corporation is formed is to engage in the practice of veterinary medicine and other necessary related activities.

III

DURATION

The period of existence and duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

IV

REGISTERED OFFICE

The initial location of the principal place of business and registered office of the corporation shall be 220 Elmcrest Street, Mountain Home, Elmore County, Idaho, and the mailing address shall be 220 Elmcrest Street, Mountain Home, Idaho 83647. The name of the initial registered agent at the above address shall be Chase Van Orden.

GOVERNING BODY

The number of the board of directors may be changed from time to time as prescribed by the by-laws, but shall be not less than one nor more than three. POWERS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

In addition to other powers, the board of directors is authorized to make, alter or amend the by-laws of the corporation, to fix the amount of capital stock to be reserved as working

capital or treasury stock, over and above its capital stock paid in, and to authorize and cause to be executed mortgages, liens or other encumbrances on the real and personal property of the corporation.

The undersigned, being the original subscriber to the capital stock hereinbefore mentioned, for the purpose of forming a corporation to do business both within and outside of the State of Idaho, and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, do make and file these articles of incorporation and the undersigned respectively agrees to take the number of shares of stock hereinbefore set opposite his name.

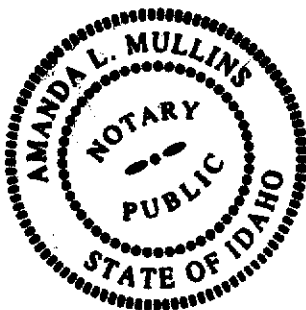


