

And, in general, to do any and all things and to exercise any and all powers which may now or hereafter be lawful for the association to do or exercise, under and pursuant to the Nonprofit Cooperative Associations Law of the State of Idaho, or of any other law which might be now or hereafter applicable to the association.

ARTICLE III

The duration of the association shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

The location and post office address of the registered office of the association shall be Cambridge Law Center, 690 Cambridge Drive, Idaho Falls, Idaho 83401, but meetings of the board of directors and of any executive committee thereof, may be held at such registered office or at such other place within or without this state, for the transaction of any business of the corporation, as the directors might, by resolution or bylaw, provide.

ARTICLE V

- a. The number and qualifications of members, terms and conditions of membership, fees or assessment of dues to carry on the business of the association, and other regulations consistent with the purposes of the association and not repugnant to the constitution and laws of the state of Idaho or of the United States, shall be as the bylaws might prescribe.
- b. The rights and interests of all members of the association shall be equal, and no member may have or acquire a greater interest therein than any other member.
- c. No capital stock shall be issued, but a membership certificate shall be issued to each member, which certificate
