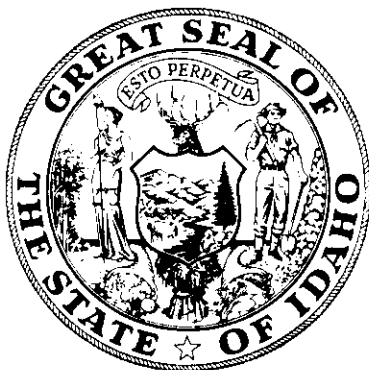

ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION

FIRST: The name of the Corporation is Development Unlimited Co., and its post office address is Post Office Box 2268, Boise, Idaho 83701.

there are no provisions among the shareholders, in proportion to their respective rights and interests.

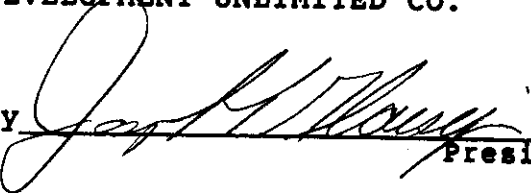
SIXTH: There are no suits pending against the Corporation in any court of which adequate provision has not been made for the satisfaction of any judgment, order or decree which may be entered against it.
