



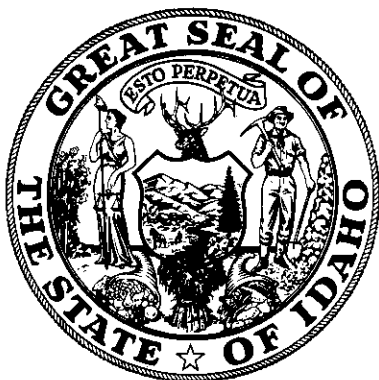
CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, each and all being natural persons of full age have this day and do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be Double J Farming, Inc.

ARTICLE II.

The purposes and objects for which this corporation is formed are:

1. To generally engage in, do and perform any enterprise, act or vocation permitted or authorized pursuant to the provisions of Idaho Business Corporation Act and Amendments thereto.

ARTICLE III.

This corporation shall have a perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV.

The total number of shares of which the corporation is authorized to issue is one million (1,000,000). The aggregate par value of such shares is Ten million dollars (\$10,000,000.00) and the par value of each share is Ten dollars (\$10.00).

ARTICLE V.

There are no provisions granting or denying preemptive rights.

ARTICLE VI.

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is: Rural Route 1, Grandview, Idaho 83624, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is: James D. Wolfe.
