ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF THE

We, the undersigned persons, acting as the incorporators of a corporation under the provisions of the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such incorporation.

ARTICLE 1.

The name of the corporation shall be: Jesus Freedom Center, INC.

ARTICLE II

The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The corporation is organized exclusively for educational, charitable, and religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provision of any further United States internal revenue law. Consistent with and subject to its qualification under Section 501 (c) (3), the corporation is organized to do any lawful activity permitted under the laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IV

No part of the net earning of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, presbyters (directors) officers or other private persons, EXCEPT THAT the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the corporation. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate of public office.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as now stated, or as it may be hereafter amended, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code.

#### ARTICLE V.

The corporation shall have all powers granted by law necessary and proper to carry out its above-stated purposes, consistent with its qualification under Section 501 (c) (3).

#### ARTICLE VI.

Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation shall be set forth in the constitution and bylaws.

#### ARTICLE VII

The address of the registered office of the corporation shall be 323 11th Ave So. City of Nampa County of Canyon,  
Idaho.

The name of the registered agent of the corporation at such office shall be: GENE MARTINEZ

#### ARTICLE VIII

This corporation shall have no voting members.

#### ARTICLE IX

The number of directors constituting initial board of directors of the corporation shall be 5 directors.

Any change in the number of directors of the corporation shall be made consistent with the provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation as set forth in the constitution and bylaws.

#### ARTICLE X.

Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be made at any annual or special meeting of the directors.

#### ARTICLE XI

In the event that this corporation ceases to function as the Jesus Freedom Center Church or is dissolve for any reason, its assets shall be distributed according to Board Members decision provided that all liabilities are paid and it qualifies at such time for exemption as an organization described in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or a successor statute.
