ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

MAY 28 1981

MOUNTAIN STATES MFG., INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That Charles N. Mullavey, being over the age of twenty-one (21) years and for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Washington Business Corporation Act, hereby certifies and adopts in duplicate the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be MOUNTAIN STATES MFG., INC., and its existence shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE II

The purpose and object of this corporation shall be to provide food services and for all other lawful purposes under the laws of the State of Washington.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that nothing herein contained shall be deemed to authorize or permit the corporation to carry on any business, to exercise any power or to do any act which a corporation formed under the Uniform Business Corporation Act of the State of Washington, or any amendment thereto or substitute therefor, may not at the time lawfully carry on or do.

ARTICLE III

Shareholders of this corporation shall have pre-emptive rights to acquire additional shares offered for sale by the corporation.

ARTICLE IV

- 1. The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation in this State shall be 2401 N.W. 65th Street, Seattle, Washington, 98117.
- The registered agent of the corporation shall be Charles
 N. Mullavey whose address is 2401 N.W. 65th Street, Seattle,
 Washington, 98117.

ARTICLE V

The authorized capital stock of the corporation shall be \$50,000 consisting of 50,000 shares of common stock of the par value of \$1.00 per share. Each share shall be entitled to one (1) vote.

The corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in its Articles of Incorporation in any manner now or hereafter prescribed or permitted by statute.

All rights of stockholders of the corporation are granted to this reservation.

ARTICLE VI

- 1. The number of directors of this corporation shall be fixed as provided in the bylaws, and may be changed from time to time by amending the bylaws as therein provided, but the number of directors shall not be less than one nor more than five.
