The undersigned, being a incorporator of a corporation under the Arkansas Business Corporation Act, adopt the following articles of incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I: The name of the corporation is ARKANSAS STATE, INC.

ARTICLE II: The period of the duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE III: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

To conduct, or to assist, and to engage in the business of collecting and disseminating of scientific knowledge, books, maps, specimens of plants, animals, minerals, light, heat and electricity; to sell and distribute books, maps, papers and exhibits of all kinds and to do any and every thing which may be necessary or convenient to carry out the foregoing objects, and particularly in the case of ARKANSAS STATE, INC.

To have one or more officers and places of business in any one or the State of ARKANSAS, and to acquire, receive hold, purchase, lease, exchange, dispose of, and convey real and personal property both in and out of the State of ARKANSAS.

To do all and everything necessary, suitable and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the achievement of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of the powers herein set forth, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms or individuals, and to do every act or thing necessary or convenient to be done in or out of or connected with the execution of objects or purposes, or any part or parts thereof, provided the same are not inconsistent with the laws under which this corporation is organized, and to use and apply such or earnings or accumulations profits to the furtherance of the objects or purposes of the corporation.

6 To enter into contracts or obligations of any kind or type essential,

14 or perform, connected with the general overall objects and purposes
15 for which this corporation is formed.

16 FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation
17 shall have authority to issue is TWO THOUSAND (2,000), all of which
18 shall be common stock having a par value of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS
19 (\$100.00) each.
