The undersigned, Dennis B. Denney, acting as the incorporator of a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

**FIRST:** The name of the corporation is: Blackfoot Plumbing Service, Inc.

**SECOND:** The period of its duration is perpetual.

**THIRD:** The purposes for which the corporation is organized are the transaction of any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

**FOURTH:** The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 1000 with no par value.

**FIFTH:** Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation are as provided in the By-Laws and as said By-Laws may be from time to time amended.
