AUCTICE: 1

The mane of this corporation is charles Traper Productions, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The specific business in which this corporation proposes primarily and initially to engage is the production of motion picture photoplays and the doing of all things necessary in connection therewith.

ARTICLE III

In addition to its purpose to engage in the business specified in Article II, this corporation is formed for the (cliowing purposes;

- (a) To purchase, acquire, own, hold, use, lease (either as lessor or lessee), grant, sell, exchange, subdivide, contagge, convey in trust, manage, reprove, construct, operate and generally deal in any and all real estate, improved or unimproved, stores, office buildings, dwelling houses, apartment houses, hotels, manufacturing plants and other buildings, and any and all other property of every kind or description, real, personal and mixed and theresoever situated, either in california, other states of the United States, the District of Ctlumbia, territories and colonies of the United States, or foreign countries.
- (b) To manufacture, fabricate, assemble, to take, purchase and otherwise acquire, ewn, hold, use, sell, assign, transfer, exchange, lease and otherwise dispose of, and to invest, trade, ceal in and deal with goods, wares and merchandise and supplies and all other personal property of every class and description.
- (c) To acquire, by purchase or otherwise, the goodwill, business, property rights, franchises and assets of every kind. With or without undertaining, either wholly or in part, the liabilities of any person, firm, association or corporation; and to acquire any property or business as a going concern or otherwise (1) by purchase of the assets thereof wholly or in part, (2) by acquisition of the shares or any part thereof, or (5) in any other manner, and to pay for the same in cash or in shares or bonds or other evidences of indebtedness of this corporation, or otherwise; to hold, maintain and operate, or in any manner dispose of, the whole or any part of the goodwill, business, rights and property so acquired, and to conduct in any lawful manner the whole or any part of any business so acquired; and to exercise all the powers necessary or convenient in and about the management of such business.

- (d) To take, purchase and otherwise acquire, own, hold, use, sell, assign, transfer, exchange, lease, mortgage, convey in trust, bledge, hypothecate, grant licenses in respect of and otherwise dispose of letters patent of the United States or any foreign country, patent rights, licenses and privileges, inventions, improvements and processes, copyrights, trade-marks and trade names, and governmental, state, territorial, country and numerical grants and concessions of every character which this corporation may deem advantageous in the prosecution of its business or in the maintenance, operation, development or extension of its properties.
- (e) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind for any lawful purpose without limit as to amount, with any person, tirm, association or corporation, municipality, county, parish, state, territory, government or other municipal or governmental subdivision.
- (f) To become a partner (either general or limited or both) and to enter into agreements of partnership, with one or more other persons or corporations, for the purpose of carrying on any business whatsoever which this corporation may deem proper or convenient in connection with any of the purposes herein set forth or otherwise, or which may be calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interests of this corporation or to enhance the value of its property or business.
- (g) from time to time to apply for, purchase, acquire by assignment, transfer or cinerwise, exercise, carry out and agoy any benefit, fight, privilege, prerogative or power conferred by, acquired under or granted by any statute, ordinance, order, license, power, authority, franchise, commission, right or privilege which any government or authority or governmental agency or corporation or other public body 5%, be empowered to enact, make or grant; to pay for, aid in, and contribute toward carrying the same into effect and to appropriate any of this corporation's shares, bonds and'or assets to defray the costs, charge, and expenses thereof.
- (h) To subscribe or cause to be subscribed for, and to take, purchase and otherwise acquire, own, hold, use, sell, assign, transfer, exchange, distribute and otherwise dispose of, the whole or any part of the shares of the capital stock, bonds, doupons, mortgages, deeds of trust, debentures, securities, obligations, evidences of indeptedness, notes, goodwill, rights, assets and property of any and every kind, or any part thereof, of any other corporation or corporations, association or associations, firm or firms, or person or persons, together with shares, rights, units or interest in, or in respect of, any trust estate, now or hereafter existing, and whether created by the laws of the State of California or of any other state, territory or country; and to operate, manage and control such properties, or any of them, either in the name of such other corporation or corporations or in the name of this corporation, and while the owners of any of said shares of capital stock, to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership of every kind and description, including the

right to vote thereon, with power to designate some person or persons for that purpose from time to time, and to the same extent as natural persons might or could de.

- (i) To promote or io aid in any manner, financially or otherwise, any person, firm, corporation or association of which any shares of stock, bodds, notes, dependers or other securities or evidences of indebtedness are held directly or indirectly by this corporation; and for this purpose to guarant. The contracts, dividends, shares, bonds, debentures, acres and other obligations of such other persons, firms, corporations or associations; and to do any other acts or things designed to protect, preserve, improve or enhance the value of such shares, bonds, notes, dependings or other securities or evidences of indebtedness.
- (1) To borrow and lend noney, but acthin, herein contained shall be construed as authorizing the business of banking, or as including the business purposes of a commercial bank, savings bank or trust company.
- (E) To issue bonds, notes, dependings or other obligations of this corporation from time to time for any of the objects or purposes of this corporation, and to secure the same by mortgage, deed of trust, pledge or otherwise, or to issue the same unso used; to purchase or otherwise acquire its ean conds, debentures or other evications of its indebtedness or obligations; to purchase, hold, sell and transfer the shares of its own capital stock to the entent and it the manner provided by the laws of the State of California as the same are now in force or may be hereafter amended.
- (1) To purchase, a quire, take, hold, own, use and enjoy, and to sell, lease, transfer, pledge, mortgage, convey, grant, assign or otherwise dispose of, and generally to invest, trade, deal in and with oil royalties, ameral rights of all kinds, mineral bearing lands and hydrocarbon products of all kinds, oil, gas and mineral leases, and all rights and interests therein, and in general products of the earth and deposits, both subsoil and surface, of every nature and description.
- (m) To carry on any business whatsoever, either as principal or as agent or both or as a partnership, which this corporation may deem proper or convenient in connection with any of the foregoing purposes or otherwise, or which may be calculated directly or indirectly to promote the interests of this corporation or to enhance the value of its property or business; to conduct its business in this state, in other states, in the bistrict of Columbia, in the territories and colonies of the United States, and in foreign countries.
- (a) To have and to exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of California upon corporations formed under the laws pursuant to

and under which this corporation is formed, as such laws are now in effect or may at any time hereafter be amended.

The foregoing statement of purposes shall be construed as a statement of both purposes and powers, and the purposes and powers stated in each clause shall, except where otherwise expressed, be in nowise limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms or previsions of any other clause, but shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers.

AUTICLE IV

The county in the State of California wherein is located the principal office for the transaction of this corporation's business is the County of Sonoma.

ANTICLE V

The amount of capital stock of this corporation is Twenty-live Thousane (\$25,600,60) pollars, and the number of shares inte which it is divided is five thousand (5,600) shares of the par value of Five (\$55,60) pollars each.
