The Idaho Prader-Willi Syndrome Association, Inc is organized exclusively for charitable, scientific, literary, and educational purposes. The Association is a non-profit organization of families whose mission is to enhance the quality of life for all individuals with Prader-Willi Syndrome by providing information and support to families, professionals, and the community. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the principal purposes of the Association shall include but not be limited to the following:

- a. Work towards increased availability and accessibility of a full range of opportunities and resources that meet individual needs;
- b. Encourage the full participation of a diverse membership;
- c. Build an effective coalition with schools to provide opportunities for quality individualized education;
- d. Encourage opportunities for quality independent living situations for adults with Prader-Willi Syndrome;
- e. Provide information, encouragement, and support to families of persons with Prader-Willi Syndrome of all ages, as well as to professionals;
- f. Promote positive community awareness of issues relating to the lives of people with Prader-Willi Syndrome and to foster the inclusion of all individuals with Prader-Willi Syndrome in their communities;
- g. Collect, create, and disseminate current information on issues related to Prader-Willi Syndrome;
- h. Promote self-advocacy for persons with Prader-Willi Syndrome;
- i. Raise, solicit, and accept funds or other contributions in furtherance of the foregoing purposes;
- j. Develop and implement programs, activities, and social events consistent with these purposes; and
- k. Increase awareness of Prader-Willi Syndrome throughout Idaho.
