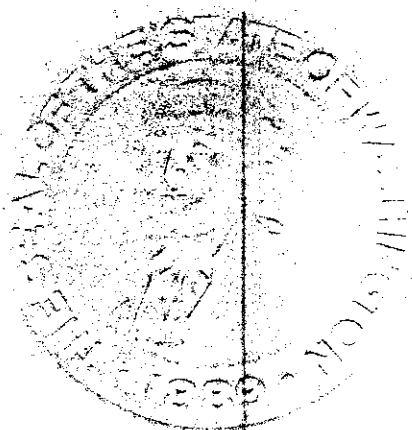

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

GREATER INLAND EMPIRE STOCK-CAR RACING ASSOCIATION, INCORPORATED

We the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more and citizens of the United States, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the provisions of the Washington Non-profit Corporation Act (RCW24.04), adopt the following articles of incorporation for such corporation:

Article I

The name of the corporation shall be the Greater Inland Empire Stock-Car Racing Association, Incorporated.

Article II

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

Article III

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are to promote, encourage and conduct stock car racing and races. To conduct and carry on its business or any part thereof, and to have one or more offices and to exercise all or any of its corporate powers and rights in the State of Washington or in the various states of the United States.

To do all and everything necessary, suitable and proper for the accomplishment of the purposes or the attainment of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of the powers hereinabove set forth, and to do every act or acts, thing or things, incidental or appurtenant to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid; provided, the same be not inconsistent with the laws under which this corporation is organized.

Article IV

The corporation is one which does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof and is organized for nonprofit purposes, and no part of any net earnings thereof shall inure to the benefit of any member or other individual.

Article V

The principal place of business of the corporation shall be

East 614 Decatur Avenue, Spokane, Washington.

#### Article VI

The management of the corporation will be vested in a Board of Trustees: the number of trustees shall not be less than five (5); and the number, qualifications, terms of office, manner of election, time and place of meeting, and powers and duties of trustees shall be such as are prescribed by the Bylaws of the Corporation.

#### Article VII

The authority to make Bylaws for the corporation is hereby vested in the Board of Trustees, provided said Bylaws are approved and adopted by a majority of all the members of the Corporation.

#### Article VIII

The corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change, or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by statute, and all rights conferred upon the members of the corporation herein are granted subject to this reservation.

#### Article IX
