Articles of Incorporation of Ruff Riders Antique Car Club Incorporated

Know all men by these presents:

That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the provisions of Chapter 10 Title 30 of the 1947 Idaho Code for the State of Idaho, and acts abendatory and supplemental thereto, and we do hereby certify and declare as follows:

That we are citizens of the United States and the State of Idaho and in persuance thereof we do hereby sign and acknowledge the following Articles of Incorporation, in triplicate originals and state as follows:

Ι

That the name of this organization shall be - Ruff Riders Antique Car Club, Incorporated.

II

That the purposes for which this non profit association is formed are the following:

To perfect an organization of persons of good character and understanding in the community, whose patriotism and loyalty to the government of the United States is unquestioned.

To meet regularly and encourage the collection, preservation, restoration, ownership, operation, exhibition, and competition of motor vehicles described as antique, vintage, classic and special interest.

To act as a source of technical and historical information pertaining to the aforesaid type of motor vehicles.

To encourage careful, prudent and skillful driving on public - highways.

To cooperate with other similar groups and organizations throughout the United States.

To carry on all similar activities except such activities deemed to be entirely political, religious, or for the advancement of a private correctial interest.

To establish, maintain and conduct a club for the social enjoyment and accommodation of members and their invited friends, and to provide a clubhouse and other conveniences, and generally to afford the cembers and their friends all the usual privilenes, advantages, conveniences and accommodations of a club.

To purchase, lease from others and otherwise acquire, sell, convey, transfer and otherwise dispose of, lease to others, nortgage, or otherwise encumber real or personal property.

\* That the association shall have the capacity to act possessed by their natural persons insofar as permitted to do so by the laws of the State of Idaho.

To acquire by purchase, gift or any other legal manner, and to own, hold, sell and transfer and hypothecate shares of stock, or bonds and other debentures of other corporations and of governments and political subdivisions thereof, and to vote the shares of capital stock of corporations while the same are held by this corporation all in the same manner as the natural person may do.

To perform every other lawful act in the furtherance of the objects of this corporation as the natural person would have the right to do.

To appoint such officers, employees, and agents as the business of the corporation may require, and to allow them compensation.

To enter into contracts or obligations of any type or kind that are essential, necessary or proper for the transaction of its ordinary affairs or for the purposes of the corporation.

#### III

This corporation is not organized for profit and shall not have capital stock. No officer, director or member of this corporation shall be entitled to any of the property, money, dividends, earnings, funds or income of this corporation.

The rights and interests of all members shall be equal, and no member can have or acquire a greater interest therein than any other member.

In the event of the revocation of the charter of this organization known as Ruff Riders Antique Car Club, Incorporated, located in Moscow, Idaho, this corporation on six months notice to the members of said corporation, shall file intention of liquidation of the affairs of the corporation. Upon dissolution, any funds, property or assets remaining after the sale of said property in settlement of all debts and obligations, shall be delivered over to a non profit organization whose interests and purposes are the same or as near as possible the same as this association.

## IV

That the membership of this corporation shall consist of the signatories to these articles of incorporation and such other persons as may from time to time be elected to the membership of the corporation by the affirmative vote of a majority of the Board of Directors and/or in compliance with the by-laws of the corporation to be adopted. Frovided however that the by-laws may provide for automatic expiration of and/or re-election to membership.

#### $\mathbf{V}$

The time for which this corporation is to exist is not limited, but it all exist perpetually unless dissolved according to law.

The place where this corporation shall transact its principal business will be Moscow, Latah County, State of Idaho.

## IIV

That the Board of Directors shall be seven in number. The method of selection and the terms of office shall be specified in the By-laws. The names and places of residence of those who are to serve as directors until their successors are duly chosen and qualified are:

All of the above incorporators are 21 years of age or over.

### VIII

The Board of Directors shall have the power to make, amend and repeal the By-laws of this corporation by the affirmative vote of 2/3 of all the directors present at any regular or special meeting of the Board. By-laws made by the Directors persuant to this article may be altered or repealed by a vote of 2/3 of the membership.

## IX

All of the undersigned incorporators are legal residents of the State of Idaho.

That a meeting of the members of the association known as Ruff Riders Antique Car Club, Incorporated, was regularly called to convene at the Latah County Fairgrounds in Moscow, Idaho at the hour of 8:00 F.M. on the 8 th day of January 1963, and that a majority of the members of said association were present and approved of the above Articles of Incorporation.
