Ray Klepinger, president, and Wynne M. Blake, secretary, of the above named corporation, respectfully show unto Arnold Williams, secretary of state of the State of Idaho, as follows:

I.

The above named corporation was organized under the laws of the State of Idaho and certificate of incorporation issued therefore on the 14th day of November, 1955.

II.

The above named corporation upon the proposal of its board of directors at the annual stockholders meeting held on June 2, 1959, adopted by a more than two-thirds vote of its stockholders a resolution amending Article VI of its Articles of Incorporation to increase the number of directors from five to seven.

NOW, THEREFORE, Ray Klepinger, president, and Wynne M. Blake, secretary-treasurer, execute and acknowledge the following articles of amendment of R-G Mining Company, Inc.

The board of directors of R-G Mining Company, Inc., at a duly called m eeting held on April 30, 1959, resolved to recommend to the stockholders of said corporation that Article VI of the Articles of Incorporation providing for five directors for said corporation be amended to increase the number of directors to seven; that resolution therefor was submitted to the annual meeting of the stockholders held on June 2, 1959 and was adopted by a more than two-

thirds vote in favor of increasing the number of directors from five to seven. BLAKE AND GIVENS

Said Article VI of the R-G Mining Company, Inc., as amended, shall hence-forth be as follows:

The business of said corporation shall be managed by a board of seven directors. The directors need not be stockholders of this corporation.
