ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
VICTORY MINES, INCORPORATED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, citizens of the United States of America and residents of the State of Idaho over the age of 21 years, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby make, sign, acknowledge and file this certificate for that purpose as follows:

ARTICLE I:

The name of this corporation shall be Victory Mines, Inc.

ARTICLE II:

The existance of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III:

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be in Custer and Lemhi Counties, Idaho, but the post office address of its registered office in the State of Idaho shall be P.O. Box 913, Boise, Idaho. The place of business of the corporation and the place of holding its annual meeting and any special meetings may be changed from time to time by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE IV:

In furtherence and not in limitation of the general powers conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho it is expressly provided that this corporation shall have the following powers and purposes:

A. To engage in, carry on, and continue a general mining business of every kind and character, including lode and placer mining operations, at any place in the State of Idaho or elsewhere; to lease, patent, acquire, buy, sell and dispose of mines, mining claims and lands, dredges, mills, and mining equipment; to own,

1 operate, build, and equip mines, mills, dredges, warehouses,
2 stores and residences and any and all other facilities intended
3 to be used for or in the conduct of a general mining business.

4 B. To purchase, own, lease, hold, represent, sell and convey
5 real estate, and to contract, lease and maintain buildings there-
6 on or such other improvements as shall be necessary or proper
7 for conducting the business of this corporation in any place in
8 the State of Idaho or elsewhere, and to buy or lease, represent
9 or sell other real property as shall be acquired by this corpora-
10 tion in the conduct of its business.

11 C. To purchase, own, hold, vote, sell, or pledge the stocks
12 and bonds of other corporations and to take in the name of the
13 corporation stocks, bonds, mortgages, notes or other evidences
14 of indebtedness or title, or security as may be acquired by
15 this corporation in the conduct of its business, and to acquire,
16 retain, deal in, and retire its own corporate stocks in so far
17 as it is lawful for it to do so.

18 D. To borrow money in the name of the corporation in such
19 amounts as the stockholders or directors may determine and to
20 issue notes, bonds, or other evidences of such indebtedness
21 and to secure the payment of the same when required by mortgages,
22 trust deeds, pledges, assignments and all other conveyances of
23 all or any part of its property, real or personal.

24 E. To acquire the goodwill, rights and property of any person,
25 firm, association or corporation and to pay for the same in cash,
26 stocks, notes or bonds of this corporation or otherwise.

27 F. To make and enter into contracts of any kind or character
28 necessary for the conduct of the business of the corporation.

29 G. To carry out all or any part of the foregoing objects of
30 the corporation, either as principal or agent, whether alone
31 or in connection with any person, firm or association, and to
32 enter into partnerships with other corporations, firms, or persons
for the attainment of the purposes of this corporation.

1 H. To carry on and to promote any other business which may
2 seem to the officers or stockholders advisable to be conducted
3 in connection with the business of the corporation or deemed
4 to promote either directly or indirectly the interest of the
5 corporation.

6 I. It is the intention hereby that the foregoing enumeration
7 of specific powers shall not be construed to limit or restrict
8 in any manner the powers of the corporation, but that the
9 corporation shall have the power to do all things necessary,
10 suitable, convenient or proper for the accomplishment of any
11 of its purposes or incidental to the powers or purposes herein
12 expressed.

13 ARTICLE V:

14 The business of the corporation shall be managed and con-
15 ducted by a Board of not less than five directors, and it shall
16 not be necessary that the directors be stockholders of the
17 corporation.

18 ARTICLE VI:

19 The Board of Directors may meet and transact the business
20 of the corporation at the principal place of business herein
21 designated or at such other place within or without the State
22 of Idaho as may be designated by resolution of the Board of
23 Directors.

24 ARTICLE VII:

25 The amount of the authorized capital stock of the corpora-
26 tion shall be five million dollars divided into five million
27 shares of par value of one dollar per share. The stock shall
28 be non-assessable and shall all be voting stock.
