ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
of the  
"SILVER STATE MINING COMPANY".

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, citizens of the United States and the State of Washington and being over the age of twenty-one years, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together and do hereby form a corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Washington, and ordain and adopt the following Articles:

ARTICLE I.

m That the name of the corporation shall be and is "SILVER STATE MINING COMPANY".

## ARTICLE II.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are to purchase, hold, own, lease or rent, and operate mines of gold, silver, copper, lead and any and all other minerals or metals and to buy and sell the same; to buy, own, sell and treat all kinds of ores; to build, operate, equip and own mills and smelters, concentrators and reduction works, as may be necessary and convenient, and to that end to purchase and own any real estate and personal property necessary or convenient therefor, and to construct and own, buy and sell any wagon road, tram road, railroad, boat, telephone or telegraph lines necessary or convenient for such business. Said business to be conducted in any and all states of the Union and British Columbia.

## ARTICLE III.

That the amount of the capital stock of said corporation shall be one million dollars to consist of one million shares of the par value of one dollar each.

## ARTICLE IV.

That the principal place of business of said Corporation shall be and is Spokane, Washington.

## ARTICLE V.

That the term of existence of said corporation shall be and is fifty (50) years from the organization of said corporation; that the number of trustees who shall manage the affairs of said corporation shall be five and the names of those who shall act as such trustees for the first six months of its existence are: C. H. Reeves, W. D. Martin, H. A. Steinke, C. S. Kalb and Jacob Hill.
