ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

THE IDAHO SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF AND THE BLIND FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE I.

Section 1: This corporation shall be called THE IDAHO SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF AND THE BLIND FOUNDATION, INC.

Section 2: This corporation shall be a non-profit corporation organized under the laws of the State of Idaho for non-profit corporations as set forth in Title 30, Chapter 3, <u>Idaho Code</u>.

Section 3: This corporation shall have a perpetual existence.

Section 4: The object and purpose of this corporation shall be to promote responsible growth and educational services at the Idaho State School for the Deaf and the Blind, Gooding, Idaho, to promote general welfare of the school's educational and extra curricular activities, create civic pride in the citizens and student body of the school, educate the general public of the attributes of supporting the school, enrich the lives of the youth attending the school system and to encourage support within the State and surrounding areas.

ARTICLE II.

ARTICLE V.
