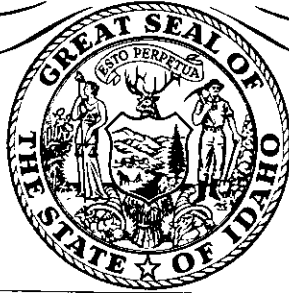

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the undersigned have on the last date herein appearing voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a religious corporation under and pursuant to Title 24, Chapter 24.08 of the laws of the State of Washington, and we do hereby certify:

FIRST: The name of this religious corporation shall be "Psychiana, Inc." and its principal place of business shall be Opportunity, Washington.

SECOND: That pecuniary profit is not the object of this religious corporation. The corporation shall be non-stock in nature and no dividends or pecuniary profit shall be declared to the members thereof.

THIRD: The purposes and objects for which the undersigned have associated themselves together as members of this religious movement are as follows:

1. To teach privately to individuals and publicly in classes the Holy Bible and the Psychiana Faith, by lectures, courses, text books, psychological and religious readings, sending of literature by mail and any other method customarily used to impart knowledge.
2. To give in manner stated above, to all people in search of intellectual spiritual knowledge, the facts concerning our vision of life as we have seen it in the past, as we see it now, and will observe it in the future.
3. To preach, teach, lecture, send by mail, and give private information on any of the arts, sciences or religions which include Psychology, Spiritual Science, the Bible, the Psychiana Faith, or any other subject that will interpret the intelligence

and knowledge of the Spirit of God, the recreation of life and the spiritual and material existence of life, within our own image.

4. To teach and practice the art of mental healing as taught by Jesus Christ and use the methods of divine healing employed by psychologists, scientific and religious mental healers, and by any other method of mental psychosomatic healing which may be devised.

5. To ordain ministers who shall perform the religious rites and ceremonies of Psychiana Faith.

6. To establish churches throughout the United States and the world for the promulgation of the Psychiana Faith, to provide for the organization of such churches, to establish offices and officers to carry on the work of the same, and to issue rules for the government of such churches.

7. To acquire and operate such churches, charitable and eleemosynary institutions as may be incident to carrying forward and spreading the religious beliefs and teachings of this organization.

8. To accept gratuities and bequests from any and all persons and to use such bequests or gifts for the charitable and religious purposes of this organization.

9. To exercise generally the powers of religious corporations enumerated in Title 24, Chapter 24.08.010 of the Washington Code Annotated, in any state in the United States and throughout the world.

10. To do any and all things in connection with and for the purpose of carrying on the objects and purposes above-mentioned, and any and all things necessary for the purpose of carrying forward the teaching of religion generally.

FOURTH: The general officers of this corporation shall be a president, vice-president, secretary-treasurer, a board of directors, which shall consist of three members, and an advisory board, which shall consist of not less than three nor more than ten members, to be selected and appointed by the board of directors from among the associate members of the corporation.

1. The principal duties of the president shall be to preside at all meetings of the board of directors, to have general supervision of the affairs of the corporation, and to convey in the name of the corporation and under his signature any or all property belonging to such corporation upon a vote of two-thirds of the members of the board of directors.
2. The principal duties of the vice-president shall be to discharge the duties of the president in the event of his absence, but the vice-president shall not have the authority to transfer or convey the property of the corporation.
3. The principal duties of the combined office of secretary-treasurer shall be to keep a record of the proceedings of the board of directors and to safely keep or cause to be kept a systematic record of all books, papers, records, and documents belonging to the corporation; to keep and account for all monies, credits, and property of every nature and keep a true and correct record of the general financial status and transactions of the corporation.
4. When called upon by the board of directors of this corporation, the advisory board shall owe a duty to render assistance and give advice upon all designated subjects and when called upon to do so by said board of directors, the advisory board members shall meet with the board of directors at the principal office of this corporation in Opportunity, Washington, or at such other point as shall be designated by the board of directors. In the event of

such meeting, the actual expenses of the advisory board shall be paid from the treasury of the corporation.

The officers shall receive such allowances for expenses and salaries for their work in this corporation as shall be voted by the board of directors, provided however, that two-thirds of the members of the board of directors shall agree upon the salary to be fixed.

FIFTH: The first or organization meeting of this corporation was held as provided by Section 24.06.010, Washington Code Annotated, on the 11th day of June, 1962, at 12102 East Sprague, Opportunity, Spokane County, State of Washington, notice of said meeting having theretofore been published in the Valley Herald, a newspaper published weekly at Opportunity, Washington, and posted, in accordance with said Section of the Washington Code. At said time and place Dr. Wilfred H. Allen was the presiding officer and Thomas W. La Cascia was the acting secretary. At said meeting Dr. Wilfred H. Allen, Thomas W. La Cascia, and \_\_\_\_\_ were unanimously elected as directors of this corporation.

It was unanimously voted at said organization meeting of this corporation that the board of directors of this corporation shall be elected once each year by the active members of this corporation at the Annual Meeting thereof, which meeting shall be held at the principal office of this corporation in Opportunity, Spokane County, State of Washington, on the first Monday of June of each calendar year. Such newly elected board of directors shall immediately take office and upon taking office shall elect the remaining officers of the corporation. Such members of the board of directors shall not be prohibited from holding office in this corporation or from voting for their own election to such office.

SIXTH: The board of directors, president, vice-president, and secretary-treasurer of the corporation shall constitute the active members of this religious corporation. There shall also be associate members who shall obtain such status by compliance with the following regulations:

1. By making written request for the teachings of this religious movement.

2. Upon the issuance to such person a membership card to be in the following form:

SEVENTH: This corporation is dedicated to the religious, social, and mental well being of the entire population of the world and shall have a perpetual existence.

EIGHTH: These Articles may be amended in accordance with the provisions of Section 24.08.010, Washington Code Annotated, provided however, that only active members of this corporation shall be considered members thereof within the meaning of such Section.

NINTH: That the names and residences of the persons forming this corporation are:

Wilfred H. Allen, residing at Spokane, Washington  
Thomas W. La Cascia, residing at Hartford, Connecticut, (temporarily)

all of whom are of full and lawful age and two-thirds of whom are citizens of the United States.
