ACCULATION OF DECORPORATION

KHOW ALL MEN HT THESE PRESENTS:

That the undereigned have on the last date havein appearing voluntarily associated ourselves tegether for the purpose of forming a religious corporation under and pursuant to Title 24, Chapter 24,000 of the lasts of the State of Washington, and we do havely eartify:

FIRST: The name of this religious corporation shall be "Psychians, Inc." and its principal place of business shall be Opportunity, Washington.

SECOND: That peruniary profit is not the object of this religious corporation. The corporation shall be non-stock in nature and no dividends or pecuniary profit shall be declared to the numbers thereof.

THIRD: The purposes and objects for which the undersigned here associated themselves together as masters of this religious movement are as follows:

- 1. To teach privately to individuals and publicly in classes the Holy Hible and the Psychiana Paith, by lectures, courses, text books, psychological and religious readings, sending of literature by mail and any other method customarily used to impart knowledge.
- 2. To give in memor stated above, to all people in search of intellectual spiritual impuledge, the facts conserning our vision of life as we have seen it in the past, as we see it now, and will observe it in the future.
- 3. To preach, teach, lecture, send by smil, and give private information on any of the arts, sciences or religious which include Psychology, Spiritual Science, the Bible, the Psychiana Faith, or any other subject that will interpret the intelligence

and imeriades of the Spirit of God, the recreation of life and the spiritual and material existence of life, within our own image.

- h. To teach and practice the art of mental healing as taught by Jesus Christ and use the methods of divine healing employed by psychologists, scientific and religious mental healers, and by any other method of mental psychosometic healing which may be devised.
- 5. To ordain ministers who shall perform the religious rites and sermonies of Psychiana Faith.
- 6. To establish churches throughout the United States and the world for the presulgation of the Psychians Faith, to provide for the organisation of such churches, to establish offices and offices to carry on the work of the same, and to issue rules for the government of such churches.
- 7. To acquire and operate such churches, charitable and elementary institutions as may be incident to carrying forward and spreading the religious beliefs and teachings of this openisation.
- 8. To accept gratuities and bequests from any and all persons and to use such bequests or gifts for the charitable and religious purposes of this organisation.
- 9. To exercise generally the powers of religious corporations emmerated in Title 2h, Chapter 2h,08,010 of the Mashington Code Armotated, An any state in the United States and throughout the world.
- 10. To do any and all things in connection with and for the purpose of earlying on the objects and purposes above-mentioned, and any and all things necessary for the purpose of carrying forward the teaching of religion generally.

POURTHS The general efficers of this corporation shall be a president, vice-president, secretary-transver, a board of directors, which shall consist of three numbers, and an advicery board, which shall consist of not less than three nor more than ten numbers, to be selected and appointed by the board of directors from smore the associate numbers of the corporation.

- 1. The principal duties of the president shall be to precide at all meetings of the board of directors, to have general supervision of the affairs of the corporation, and to convey in the name of the corporation and under his aignature any or all property balonging to such corporation upon a voteof two-thirds of the numbers of the board of directors.
- 2. The principal duties of the vice-president shall be to discharge the duties of the president in the event of his absence, but the vice-president shall not have the authority to transfer or convey the property of the corporation.
- In the principal duties of the combined office of secretary—
 treasurer shall be to keep a record of the proceedings of the
 board of directors and to safely keep or cause to be kept a
 systematic record of all books, papers, records, and documents
 belonging to the corporations to keep and account for all monies,
 credits, and prope by of every nature and keep a true and correct
 record of the general financial status and transactions of the
 corporation.
- he When called upon by the board of directors of this corporations the advisory board shall one a duty to render assistance and give advice upon all designated subjects and when called upon to do so by said board of directors, the advisory board numbers shall meet with the board of directors at the principal office of this corporation in Oppostunity, Eastington, or at such other paint as shall be designated by the board of directors. In the event of

such meeting, the actual expenses of the advisory board shall be paid from the treasury of the corporation.

The officers shall receive such allowances for expenses and salaries for their mork in this corporation as shall be voted by the board of directors, provided however, that two-thirds of the members of the board of directors shall agree upon the salary to be fixed.
