KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, all being full-age citizens of the United States and members of The Rotarun Ski Club, an unincorporated fraternal organization, the object of which is not pecuniary profit, do, in accordance with the rules, regulations and discipline of said association, as duly elected directors thereof, and by virtue of Chapter 11 of Title 30, Idaho Code, hereby incorporate ourselves and form a corporation as follows, to-wit:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is:

THE ROTARUN SKI CLUB, INC.

SECOND: The purposes for which the said Ski Club is formed and incorporated are stated as follows:

- 1. To promote the art and enjoyment of skiing and in so doing to provide whenever and wherever possible adequate instruction in skiing by competent personnel.
- 2. To provide, Maintain and operate a suitable skiing area and facilities necessary for the operation thereof.
- 3. To provide and maintain a Ski Patrol for the above area consisting of adequately trained personnel, the duties of said patrol to be clearly outlined in the matter of good skiing practices, courtesy, safety and first-aid.
- 4. To provide, maintain and operate a "Warming Hut" for the convenience of people using the above named area.
- 5. To promote at all times good fellowship and good sportsmanship among all the people using the facilities of the area.
- 6. To word the By Laws, etc. of the said Ski Club to conform to the requirements of the Intermountain Division

- of the United States Ski Association with a view to possible affiliation with this organization.
- 7. To acquire right, title and/or interest in such land and other property as may be necessary for the successful operation of the area above named.

THIRD: The term for which said corporation shall exist is perpetuity.

FOURTH: The principal place of business of said corporation shall be at Rotarun Ski Area, Hailey, Idaho.

FIFTH: The number of directors or trustees shall be thirteen.

SIXTH: On August 16, 1963, at 8:00 o'clock P. M., an election of officers and directors of said club was held, to operate under and in conformity with Section 30-1101, Idaho Code; that a majority of the members of such club or association who were present at such meeting voted at such election, and by their vote the following motion was duly made, seconded and unanimously adopted:

RESOLVED, that a corporation be organized, to be known as "The Rotarun Ski Club, Inc."; that A. E. Richards, J. L. Hurst, Mrs. Teresa Bergin, Oliver Adams, L. F. Heagle, R. C. Stephens, Thomas C. Fica, John Combs, Bill Woody, Paul Jones, John Davies, Jr., Leslie G. Outzs and the President of the Rotary Club each year, be ap cinted a cormittee to perfect such corporate organization; that A. E. Richards serve as the first President and Director, J. L. Hurst, as Vice-President and Director, Mrs. Teresa Bergin, as Secretary and Director, Oliver Adams, as Treasurer and Director, L. F. Heagle, R. C. Stephens, Thomas C. Fica, John Combs, Bill Moody, Paul Jones, John Davies, Jr., Leslie G. Outzs and the President of the Rotary Club each year, as Directors, for the first year and until their successors are elected and qualified.


