AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **Perpetual Existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Pierce, Idaho** in the County of **Clearwater** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
FIRST PROTESTANT CHURCH OF PIERCE, IDAHO**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned members of The First Protestant Church of Pierce, Idaho, all being over the age of twenty-one years and pursuant to the express desires and direction of the membership of said church, do hereby, under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, and particularly the provisions of Title 30, Chapter 11, of the Idaho Code, associate ourselves together to form a corporation and for that purpose do certify as follows:

I.

The name of this corporation shall be **THE FIRST PROTESTANT CHURCH OF PIERCE, IDAHO.**

II.

That the corporation is created for the accomplishment of religious, social and benevolent purposes and shall have for the accomplishment of such purposes the following particular powers and authority, to-wit:

- A. To establish and maintain a place or places together with the necessary facilities for use as a place of public worship in the City of Pierce, Clearwater County, Idaho, or in such other location as the Board of Deacons shall deem proper.
- B. To establish and provide facilities for religious instruction and to further religious and charitable work and provide for the social welfare of its members and the community in which such facilities may be located.
- C. To acquire by purchase, gift or any other lawful means and to own, hold, manage, lease or exchange both real and personal property; to erect such buildings, memorials or structures as may be necessary for the fulfillment of the objects and purposes of this corporation and to borrow money and secure the repayment of same by pledges,

mortgages or other lawful obligation of the whole or any part of the property of said corporation.

- D. To receive and accept donations, gifts or bequests and to do all other things necessary and proper for the accomplishment of the purposes set forth herein.

III.

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

IV.

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation is and shall be Pierce, Clearwater County, Idaho.

V.

This corporation is not organized for penuniary profit and it shall not have or issue capital stock, but shall be supported by gifts, bequests, contributions, benefits and dues of its members. Membership in the corporation shall not entitled the person to any interest whatsoever in the assets of the corporation, but only to participate in the management of the affairs of the corporation through meetings of the members legally called, and no part of receipts or income of said corporation shall inure to the benefit or be distributable to any individual member, members or officers of the corporation.

VI.

This corporation shall support the doctrine and tenets and be subject to the laws, usages and customs of The First Protestant Church of Pierce, Idaho, as may from time to time be established, made and declared by the lawful authority of said church.

VII.

This corporation shall have a Board of Deacons composed of five adult members, which board shall have the management and control of the real property of the corporation as well as the control of the promotion, operation and maintenance of said corporation, together

with its spiritual direction. This board shall be elected and organized in accordance with the laws, customs or usages of The First Protestant Church of Pierce, Idaho.

VIII.

Any person who is duly and properly enrolled as a member of The First Protestant Church of Pierce, Idaho, shall be a member of this corporation, and any person who shall subsequently become duly and properly enrolled as a member of The First Protestant Church of Pierce, Idaho, shall likewise become a member of the corporation.

IX.

The names and addresses of those persons duly elected to the Board of Deacons of this corporation for the year 1973 and until such election or qualification of their successors, which persons are also the original incorporators are as follows:

Clara H. Bonner, Pierce, Idaho;
Ronald Kinard, Pierce, Idaho;
Albert G. Carr, Weippe, Idaho; and
Timothy P. Bonner, Kelso, Washington.

That the Board of Deacons members hereinbefore named were chosen at an election held at the corporation's place of business at Pierce, Clearwater County, Idaho, at the hour of 3:00 o'clock p. m. on the ^{15th} ~~1st~~ day of July, 1973, pursuant to legal notice thereof duly given; that a majority of the members of the organization present cast their votes at such election with the result that the Board of Deacons above stated were unanimously elected for the year of 1973.

That the following notice of said meeting at which time the said Board of Deacons were elected was published in the Clearwater Tribune, a weekly newspaper, the official publication of Clearwater County, printed and published at Orofino, Clearwater County, Idaho, said notice appearing therein as follows:


