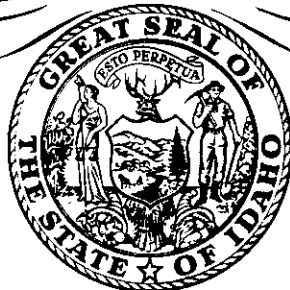

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
BUYERS ENTERPRISES, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated pursuant to the Business Corporation Act of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is **Buyers Enterprises, Inc.**

ARTICLE II

The corporation is to have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation is 6916 Folk Street, Boise, Ada County, Idaho.

ARTICLE IV

The corporation is authorized to issue one class of share of capital stock to be designated as common stock.

The total number of par value shares authorized is 400 shares of the par value of \$25.00 per share. The aggregate par value of said authorized shares of common stock is \$10,000.00.

ARTICLE V

The purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

(a) To carry on a general investment business including the purchase, sale and improvement of all items of commerce not prohibited by law and to handle, deal in and with such items including buying, selling and generally dealing in all supplies and parts in connection therewith.

(b) To own, lease, buy and otherwise acquire real estate, and to lease, sell and dispose of real estate, and to enter into and perform any and all contracts in which any person, firm, corporation or association may lawfully engage.

(c) To borrow and lend money and to do each and everything necessary, suitable or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any one or more of the objects herein enumerated, or which at any time appear conducive to or expedient for the protection or benefit of this corporation.

#### ARTICLE VI
