Article 8: Upon dissolution the assets shall be distributed:

In the event of the dissolution of the Corporation, no officer or director shall be entitled to any distribution or division of its remaining property or its proceeds, and the balance of all money and other property which the Corporation receives from any source, after the payment of all debts and obligations of the Corporation, shall be used or distributed exclusively for purposes within the intentment of § 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code as the same now exists or as it may be amended from time to time. Any such assets not so distributed shall be distributed by the district court of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for the purposes or to such organizations as such court shall determine to be consistent with the purposes of the Corporation.

Article 9: By-laws:

Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the Corporation shall be set forth in the Bylaws. The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall be authorized to amend the Corporation's Bylaws at a properly noticed special or regular meeting of the Board of Directors.

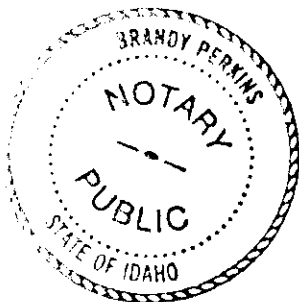
