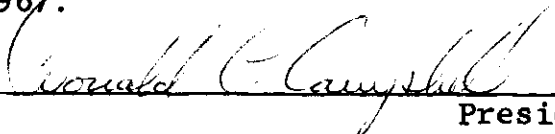
President and Assistant Secretary, respectively, of said corporation, do hereby certify and declare as follows:
