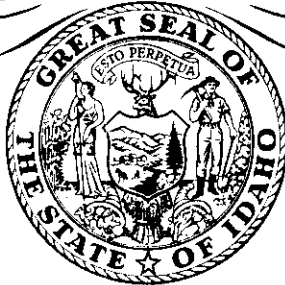

LEWISTON SOCIETY OF THE METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH, INC.

a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, filed in this office on the **13th** day of **December** 19^{**68**}, original articles of amendment, as provided by Section **30-1103, Idaho Code, amending ARTICLE I, changing corporate name to FIRST UNITED METHODIST CHURCH OF LEWISTON, IDAHO, INC.; ARTICLE III, purposes; ARTICLE V, membership; ARTICLE VI, Trustees,**

and that the said articles of amendment contain the statement of facts required by law, and ^{will be} are recorded on ~~Film No.~~ **microfilm** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT
OF
LEWISTON SOCIETY OF THE METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH, INC.,
a Religious Corporation

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Lloyd N. Alden ,
presiding officer, and Shirley Stevenson, Secretary, of the meeting
of members hereinafter referred to, of the above named corporation,
respectfully represent;

That the above named corporation was incorporation under
the laws of the State of Idaho on the 30th day of April, 1938.

That on the 6th day of November, 1968, at a regular
meeting of the members of the Lewiston Society of The Methodist
Episcopal Church, Inc., at which meeting a quorum of members of said
corporation were present in person, the following Resolution was
duly moved and seconded:

BE IT RESOLVED that Article I of the Articles of
Incorporation of Lewiston Society of The Methodist Episcopal
Church, Inc., a Religious Corporation, be amended to read:

ARTICLE I.

(NAME)

"The name of this corporation shall be "FIRST UNITED
METHODIST CHURCH OF LEWISTON, IDAHO, INC."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Article III of the Articles
of Incorporation of Lewiston Society of The Methodist
Episcopal Church, Inc., a Religious Corporation, be amended
to read:

ARTICLE III.

(PURPOSES)

"The purposes for which this corporation is formed are
as follows:

To establish and maintain a church in the City of Lewiston,
in Nez Perce County, State of Idaho, and in connection there-
with, a suitable and customary organization for the purpose
of public worship and religious training according to the
rules and discipline of the United Methodist Church, under
the supervision of the Pacific Northwest Conference of the
United Methodist Church, which said church shall be subject

to the privileges of the government of the United Methodist Church as from time to time authorized and declared by the General Conference of said church; to purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, manage, sell, mortgage and otherwise encumber or dispose of real or personal property of any kind whatsoever; to receive, hold and enjoy gifts, devises and legacies; to borrow money, to execute and issue notes and bonds evidencing its indebtedness, and to secure indebtedness by pledge, mortgage or other encumbrance of its property; to rent and lease real property; to do any and all things convenient and incidental to the purposes herein expressed, and generally to have and exercise all such powers as are by law conferred on corporations of like character, without in any particular limiting any of the objects or purposes or powers of the corporation, the objectives and purposes of the corporation shall be from time to time to do any one or more or all of the acts and things herein set forth, and all such acts, things and business in any manner connected therewith or necessary, incidental, convenient or auxiliary thereto or calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interests of the corporation or the members thereof, or enhance the value of any of its property or rights as such corporation, may lawfully do; and in carrying on its objectives and purposes, or for the purpose of attaining any of its objects, to do any and all things and exercise any and all other powers not prohibited by law."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Article V of the Articles of Incorporation of Lewiston Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church, Inc., a Religious Corporation, be amended to read:

ARTICLE V.

(MEMBERSHIP)

"The members of this corporation shall be all persons who are now or may hereafter become members of the First United Methodist Church of Lewiston, Idaho, under the rules and discipline of the United Methodist Church, as embodied and set forth in the Rules and Discipline of the United Methodist Church, published by the authority of the General Conference thereof in the year 1968, and any amendments or additions thereto."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Article VI of the Articles of Incorporation of Lewiston Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church, Inc., a Religious Corporation, be amended to read:

ARTICLE VI.

(TRUSTEES)

"The Trustees of this corporation shall have charge of the managements of the real property of this corporation and the promotion, operation and management thereof, and shall have charge of, and the management of, all church property for the use of the members of this corporation and the properly constituted church authorities, SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to all restrictions placed upon such powers as embodied and set forth in the Rules and Discipline of the United Methodist

Church published by the authority of the General Conference thereof in the year 1968, and any amendments or additions thereto. The number, qualifications and terms of office, manner of election, time, place and manner of calling meetings, and other powers and duties of the Trustees shall be prescribed by the By-Laws."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the remaining Articles of Incorporation, as now on file in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Idaho be ratified and approved unaltered.

That upon being put to a vote, the aforesaid Resolution was passed by a majority vote of the members present and the presiding officer and Secretary of said meeting were advised to issue their certificate to the Secretary of State of the State of Idaho for the purpose of amending the Articles of Incorporation in compliance with this Resolution.
