

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF THE

CUBA MINING COMPANY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, C. Fred. Kratzer, Edward T. Elton, William T. Hooper, C. K. Cartwright and A. G. Kerns, all citizens and residents of the State of Idaho, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation and becoming a body corporate under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we hereby declare and set forth:

FIRST.

The name of this corporation shall be the

CUBA MINING COMPANY.

SECOND.

This corporation is formed for the purpose of purchasing, selling, buying, leasing, working and operating mines and mining claim water rights, millsites and easements incident thereto, and such other property as may be lawfully acquired by a corporation under the laws of the United States, the State of Idaho, and elsewhere; purchasing, renting, leasing and building mills, concentrators, and other works and machinery necessary for the purpose of milling, concentrating, reducing and handling ores and the products thereof; buying, selling, working, milling and concentrating ores.

THIRD.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be in the City of Wallace, County of Shoshone, State of Idaho.

FOURTH.

This corporation shall exist for fifty years.

FIFTH.

There shall be five Directors of this corporation; the names and residence of those appointed for the first year or until the first annual meeting of the stockholders are as follows:

C. K. Cartwright,	Director and President, Haile, Idaho;
Edward T. Elom,	Director and Vice-President, Wallace, Idaho;
C. Fred. Kratzer,	Director and Secretary, Haile, Idaho;
William T. Hooper,	Director and Treasurer, Haile, Idaho;
A. G. Kerns,	Director, Wallace, Idaho,

SIXTH.

The amount of capital stock of this corporation shall be one million shares of the par value of ~~one dollar~~ <sup>one dollar</sup> each.

The stock is declared to be fully paid upon the following consideration: The corporation pays one million shares of the capital stock for the conveyance to it of the "Cuba" and ledge mining claims situated in Placer Center Mining District, County of Shoshone, State of Idaho.

Two hundred thousand shares of this capital stock is donated to the corporation by the subscribers or incorporators, and shall be known as Treasury Stock.
