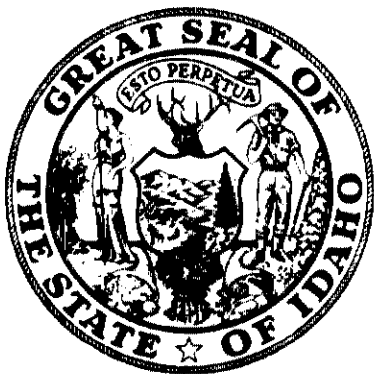

FORM FOR AMENDING ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION (SOVEREIGN CHURCH)

FOR USE WHEN A SOVEREIGN CHURCH AMENDS ITS EXISTING
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 30-327 and 30-328 of the Idaho Nonprofit Corporations Act, the undersigned adopts the following Articles of Amendment and Restatement to the Articles of Incorporation:

(1) The name of record of the corporation is:

FAITH EVANGELISTIC CENTER, INC.

(2) These amendments and restatements of the Articles of Incorporation were adopted at a meeting of a quorum of the members by at least a two-thirds vote on May 13th, 1991.

(3) That the Articles of Incorporation be, and hereby are, amended and restated in their entirety to be and to read as follows:

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of the

FAITH ASSEMBLY of GOD, INC.

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation shall be: FAITH ASSEMBLY of GOD, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III.

The corporation is organized exclusively for educational, charitable, and religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provision of any further United States internal revenue law. Consistent with and subject to its qualification under Section 501 (c) (3), the corporation is organized to do any lawful activity permitted under the laws of the State of Idaho.

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ARTICLE IV

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers or other private persons, EXCEPT THAT the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the corporation. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as now stated, or as it may be hereafter amended, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code.

ARTICLE V.

The corporation shall have all powers granted by law necessary and proper to carry out its above-stated purposes, consistent with its qualification under Section 501 (c) (3).

ARTICLE VI.

Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation shall be set forth in the constitution and bylaws.

ARTICLE VII.

The address of the registered office of the corporation shall continue to be:

ARTICLE VIII.

The members of this corporation shall be as set forth in the constitution and bylaws.

ARTICLE IX.

The number of trustees (directors) constituting the board of directors of the corporation shall be 6 directors.

Any change in the number of directors of the corporation shall be made consistent with the provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation as set forth in the constitution and bylaws.

ARTICLE X.

Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be made at any annual or special meeting of the members.

The board of directors shall adopt a resolution setting forth the proposed amendment and directing that it be submitted to a vote of its members. Written or printed notice setting forth the proposed amendment or a summary of the changes to be effected thereby shall be given to each member entitled to vote at such a meeting within the time and in the manner provided in the constitution and bylaws. The proposed amendment shall be adopted upon receiving a two-third vote of those present at such meeting.

ARTICLE XI.

In the event that this corporation ceases to function as an Assemblies of God church or is dissolved for any reason, its assets shall be distributed to the Southern Idaho District Council of the Assemblies of God, provided it qualifies at such time for exemption as an organization described in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or a successor statute. In the event that the Southern Idaho District Council of the Assemblies of God does not so qualify, then the assets of this corporation shall be distributed to the General Council of the Assemblies of God, provided it qualifies at such time for exemption as an organization described in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or a successor statute.

30-327. Articles of Amendment.-- The articles of amendment shall be executed in duplicate by the corporation by its president or a vice-president and by its secretary or an assistant secretary, or, if there are no members, by a majority of the directors in office. The articles of amendment shall be verified by one (1) of the persons who executes them, and shall set forth:

(a) The name of the corporation.

(b) If the amendment alters any provision of the original or amended articles of incorporation, an identification by reference or description of the altered provision and a statement of its
