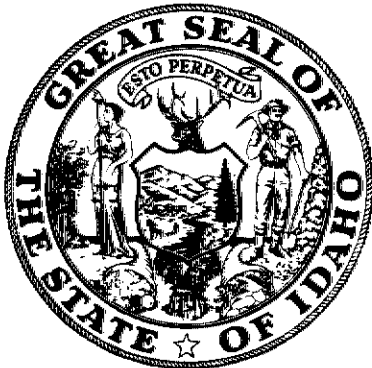

I.

The name of this professional corporation shall be
STEVEN M. BRUCE, D.M.D., P.A.

II.

The period of duration of this corporation shall be per-
petual.

III.

The corporation is organized to render professional den-
tal services pursuant to Idaho Code Section 30-1307 and organized
under the Professional Services Corporations, Chapter 13, Title
30, Idaho Code. Pursuant to Idaho Code Section 30-1312. The
Business Corporation Act of the State of Idaho is applicable to
the extent that there are no conflicts with Chapter 13, Title 30.

IV.

This corporation shall have the authority to issue 5,000
shares of corporate stock, all of one class, and each having a
par value of one dollar (\$1.00).

V.

The initial registered office of this corporation is
