

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF PLYMOUTH CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:- That we, the undersigned, have voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of organizing a private Corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, and for this purpose we do hereby set forth and declare as follows:

FIRST.

That the name of this Corporation is and shall be PLYMOUTH CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH.

SECOND.

That the place where the principal business of this corporation shall be transacted is, New Plymouth, in the County of Canyon, State of Idaho.

THIRD.

That the term for which this organization shall exist is fifty years.

FOURTH.

That the purposes for which this organization is formed are; acquiring, owning and holding such real and personal property as may be required for the use of said Corporation in conducting religious services and meetings; owning and holding such other real and personal property as may be required in maintaining and operating such property; borrowing such money as may be necessary for the purchasing, bettering, enlarging, maintaining and operating such property, and mortgaging and hypothecating the same, or any part thereof for the purpose of securing the payment of any money so borrowed; selling and conveying such property, or any part thereof, and the doing and performing of all such other acts and things as may be essential to the full and complete carrying out of the purposes above set forth.

FIFTH.

That the number of Directors of this corporation shall be five; that at a meeting held in the Village of New Plymouth in the County of Canyon and State of Idaho, on March 1st. 1901, at which a majority of the members of this corporation were present and voted the following persons were elected directors of this organization, to hold office until January 1 1902;
