I, **FRANKLIN GIRARD**, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

GRANGE GAS AND SUPPLY CO.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the 4th day of October, A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-four and is duly recorded in Book 1-28 of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 22-2008, Idaho Code, Annotated.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation by the name stated in the articles, for fifty (50) years from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at Sandpoint, in the County of Bonner, Idaho, and as such are entitled to all the rights and privileges granted to, and subject to the limitations and requirements of a Cooperative Marketing Association, as provided in said Chapter 20 of Title 22, Idaho Code, Annotated, as amended by Chapter 212 of the 1933 Session Laws.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF A CO-OPERATIVE ASSOCIATION NOT FOR PROFIT
.....

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned citizens and residents of the United States and of the State of Idaho desiring to form a co-operative association not for profit do hereby associate and incorporate ourselves as a corporation and a co-operative association not for profit and execute and adopt the followingsArticles:

ARTICLE I

The name of this association shall be "Grange Gas and Supply Co."

ARTICLE II

The objects and purposes for which the association is formed are:

(A) To buy, sell and deal in gasoline, oil, automobile tires and accessories, and such other articles and supplies as are commonly kept and sold at automobile service stations, and other articles of personal property for the benefit of it's members only.

(B) To buy, sell and generally to deal in any and all kinds of agricultrual and farm products, and any and all kinds of farm machinery, tools, equipment, fertilizers, bags, twine and any and all other kinds of supplies and personal property for use on farms for the benefit of it's members only.

(C) To receive gifts and devices and to purchase, acquire, sell, convey, lease (as Lessor or Lessee) and hold real estate as the purpose of the association may require.

(D) To enter into all lawful contracts and incur indebtedness and obligations necessary and proper in the transaxtion of it's business affairs; to borrow money, and to issue notes, bonds, mortgages and other evidences of indebtedness; and to do and to per form all acts and things necessary and proper to carry out the purp poses of it's corporation; and to excercise all the rights and powers of an ordinary corporation and consistent with the acts under which it is incorporated for the benefit of it's members only.

(E) To engage in and to do all kinds of business for the benefit of it's members not inconsistent with the provisions of the act under which they are associated.

ARTICLE III

The principle place of business of this association shall be Sandpoint, Idaho.

ARTICLE IV

The term of existence of this corporation shall be fifty
(50) years.

ARTICLE V

There shall be no Capital Stock. The property rights and interest
of each member shall be equal.

ARTICLE VI

Members of this corporation shall be limited to members of
the Grange in good standing.

ARTICLE VII

The number of trustees of this corporation shall be five,
but such number may be decreased to not less than three or
increased to not more than nine by the by-laws. The names
of the trustees who shall manage the business and affairs
of the corporation until December 1, 1934 are H. S. Crowder,
F. L. Cochrane, A. A. Holien, Fred E. Foster, Harold V Kiebert,
which trustees were duly elected by the membership.
