**F.O.P. SEARCH AND RESCUE PATROL, INC.,**

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Fourth** day of **October** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-six** and **will be** **Microfilm** **7** duly recorded on **File No.** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Pocatello,** in the County of **Bannock,** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

F.O.P. SEARCH AND RESCUE PATROL, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, citizens of the United States of America, all over the age of twenty-one years, desiring to form a not for profit, benevolent, charitable, fraternal, and educational corporation under Sections 30-1101 to 30-1110 inclusive of the Statutes of the State of Idaho, and the amendments thereto, do for the purposes and objects hereinafter stated hereby associate ourselves with the intention of forming such corporation, and do hereby agree and declare:

## I.

The name of this corporation shall be "F.O.P. Search and Rescue Patrol, Inc."

## II.

That this corporation is formed for social, benevolent and patriotic purposes, and especially, but not in limitation of its general powers:

A. To execute search and rescue operations and other related duties as shall arise.

B. To train and drill its members in the arts of first aid and of the conduct of search and rescue operations.

C. To cultivate social intercourse among its members and assist in improving the health and physical condition of its members.

D. To acquire, by purchase or otherwise, own, hold, manage, lease, sell and convey such real and personal property, and erect such

buildings, memorials, club houses and other structures as may be necessary or incident to the carrying out of the purposes herein mentioned; to borrow money for the furtherance of such purposes and to secure the same by obligations, pledges, mortgages, or the issuance of bonds or debentures secured by pledges, deeds of trust, or mortgages of or upon the whole or any part of its property; to take and receive donations of real and personal property by gift, grant, devise or bequest;

E. To manage and conduct entertainments, excursions, athletic contests and social meetings of its members; to promote and conduct entertainments, amusements and diversions to defray the expenses of this corporation; to promote and encourage the sport, pleasure, exercise and recreation of its members, and to enter into any and all contracts necessary in conducting its affairs; and to lend money, and render such benevolent aid and comfort to its members as may be provided by its by-laws; and to do any and all other things whatsoever which may be requisite, necessary and proper in and about the carrying out of the purposes and objects for which this corporation is formed.

### III.

This corporation shall have and exercise all powers granted to corporations of this nature by the laws of the State of Idaho.

### IV.

That duration of this corporation shall be unlimited and perpetual.

### V.

The location and post office address of this corporation's registered office in the State of Idaho is in the Bannock County Sheriff's Office, Courthouse, Pocatello, Idaho.

VI.

The number of directors of this corporation shall not be less than five nor more than one-hundred, as may be fixed by the Constitution and By-Laws. The qualifications of directors, their remuneration, terms of office, manner of election, time, place and manner of calling meetings, and their powers and duties may be prescribed by the Constitution and By-Laws.

VII.

The corporate membership shall consist of those persons identified as such on membership records to be maintained under the supervision of the Board of Directors in accordance with By-Laws adopted by the Corporation, not inconsistent with law or with these Articles of Incorporation.

VIII.

The corporation shall have all of the powers granted by Idaho Code Section 30-1106, including, but not by way of limitation, the power to acquire, hold, sell, dispose of, pledge or mortgage any real estate or personal property or mixed property, the ownership of which is consistent with the corporation's purposes; provided, however, that any purchase, or any sale, mortgage or other disposition of real estate may be accomplished only by authority of the Corporate Membership at its Annual Meeting or at a meeting duly called with notice of the particular purpose, said notice to be given by mail to the members of the corporation, in each case not less than ten (10) days nor more than thirty (30) days before the date of such called meeting. Any decision by the corporation pursuant to this paragraph shall be valid only if adopted by a simple majority of the members present and voting at the meeting at which such decision is made, a quorum being present.





X.

This corporation shall have no capital stock and shall not engage in business for profit, but shall be supported by gifts, bequests, benefits, contributions, and fees and dues paid by members. Membership in the corporation shall be governed and controlled as provided in the Constitution and By-Laws of this corporation.

No part of the earnings, income, or receipts of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of or be distributed to any individual, member or members of this corporation.

XI.

The officers by whom, and the manner in which the objects and purposes of this corporation shall be carried out, shall be as provided by the Constitution and By-Laws of this Corporation.

XII.

The Constitution and the By-Laws of this Corporation may be made, amended, or repealed at any regular business meeting of the Corporation which there is a quorum, by a majority vote of the members present, provided the Board of Directors has previously considered the merits of the change. No amendment shall be put to vote, unless written notice shall have been mailed to each member of this organization at least two weeks previous to the meeting at which the amendment is to be voted on, said notice to state the proposed amendment.
