ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

οf

CHILDREN'S HOME FINDING AND AID SOCIETY OF NORTH IDAHO, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, being all citizens of the United States and citizens and residents of the State of Idaho, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a charitable corporation pursuant to Chapter 11, Title 29, Idaho Codes Annotated, and under all laws of the State of Idaho applicable to such corporations, and we hereby adopt and certify the following articles of incorporation, to-wit:

ARTICLE I

AID SOCIETY OF NORTH IDAHO, INC."

ARTICLE II. (Principal Office)

The principal office of the corporation shall be located at Lewiston, Nez Perce County, Idaho.

ARTICLE III. (Duration)

The duration of the corporation shall be fifty (50) years.

ARTICLE IV. (Purposes)

The purposes of this corporation are:

To seek out, find, receive and care for children who are homeless, neglected or physically disabled or incapacitated; to provide temporary or permanent homes for such children and to maintain and educate them; to receive surrenders of such children from their parents, guardians or persons having their custody; to authorize the education of such children and to provide for the temporary care of such children in homes without adoption; to supervise the care given to children placed in homes; to place children in homes for adoption and to permit and consent to the adoption of such children upon legal proceedings for that purpose;

To maintain a home or homes for the caring for such children; to purchase or otherwise acquire real and personal property for the purposes of the corporation, and to sell or otherwise dispose of the same; to lend money and to borrow money for the purposes for which the corporation is organized, and to secure the payment of money borrowed by mortgages or liens upon the property of the corporation; to receive donations, contributions, gifts, legacies and bequests; to manage and invest the funds of the corporation and generally and without limitation to exercise all of the powers granted by law to corporations of this character, and to cooperate with other associations, agencies and corporations engaged in like work.

ARTICLE V. (Membership)

The members of this corporation shall be the persons subscribing these articles, the directors herein named, and such other persons as aid the corporation, contribute to its funds, accept its articles and by-laws and lawful regulations adopted thereunder, and are elected to membership by the members or by the board of directors. Members may be of different classes, but all members shall have one vote and no more.

ARTICLE VI. (Directors)

The directors of the corporation shall be such number of persons, not less than five(5) and not more than thirty-five(35), as may be prescribed by the by-laws, and until the first meeting and organization of the corporation the following shall serve as directors thereof, to-wit:

ARTICLE VII

That heretofore a meeting of the members of the voluntary association known as Children's Home Finding and Aid Society of/Idaho was duly and regularly called to convene at room 1, Lewiston National Bank Building, Lewiston, Idaho, at two o'clock P.M., June 12, 1935; that notice of the said meeting was duly and regularly given by publication for two weeks in the Lewiston Morning Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation published in said City of Lewiston; that first publication thereof was on the 24th day of May, 1935, and the last publication on the 6th day of June, 1935; that the said meeting was held for the purpose of authorizing the organization of this corporation and of electing directors thereof, and that a like notice was posted in a conspicuous place in the building where such election was to be held for a like time; that the said meeting was duly and regularly held and that at said meeting these articles of incorporation were approved, and all of the directors herein named were elected by unanimous vote of the members present, and that at said meeting Mrs. James E. Babb was the presiding officer and T. S. Ward was the secretary.
