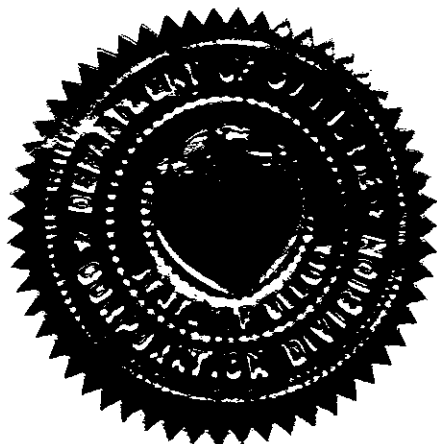

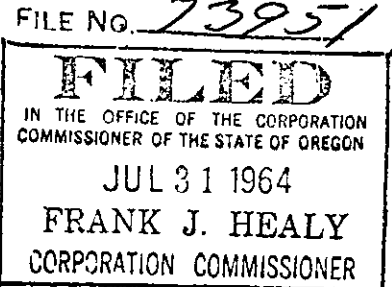

## Articles of Incorporation

OF

ORCOLO CORP.

The undersigned natural person(s) of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as incorporators under the Oregon Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

### ARTICLE I

①The name of this corporation is ORCOLO CORP.

and its duration shall be perpetual

### ARTICLE II

①The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- (a) To engage in the business of buying, selling, owning, holding, encumbering and leasing personal property and equipment of every kind and description.
- (b) To exercise any and all rights and powers which a corporation may now or hereafter exercise.
- (c) To endorse, guarantee and secure the payment and satisfaction of bonds, coupons, mortgages, deeds of trust, debentures, securities, obligations and evidences of indebtedness, and also to guarantee and secure the payment or satisfaction of interest on obligations and of dividends on shares of the capital stock of other corporations; also, to assume the whole or any part of the liabilities, existing or prospective, of any person, firm, corporation or association, and to aid in any manner any other person, firm or corporation with which it has business dealings or whose stocks, bonds, or other obligations, are held or are in any manner guaranteed by the corporation, and to do any other acts and things for the preservation, protection, improvement or enhancement of the value of such stocks, bonds or other obligations.

The foregoing statement of purposes shall be construed as a statement of both purposes and powers, and the purposes and powers in each clause shall, except where otherwise expressed, be in no wise limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms or provisions of any other clause but shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers.

ARTICLE III

©The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is one thousand (1,000) shares of a par value of \$5 per share.

ARTICLE IV

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 800 Pacific Building,
