ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

LEWIS - CLARK INTERAGENCY COUNCIL, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves together for the intention of forming a non-profit cooperative association, under the provisions of Chapter 10, Title 30, IDAHO CODE, and do hereby execute, subscribe and acknowledge in triplicate, the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE ONE

The name by which this Corporation shall be known is the LEWIS-CLARK INTERAGENCY COUNCIL, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

The objects and purposes for which this Corporation is formed are to foster community recognition and understanding of the social welfare needs of the people and to stimulate interest and participation in meeting them effectively; to cooperate with existing agencies and the Twin-City United Crusade in bringing about an orderly development of a well balanced social welfare program; to work for the prevention and elimination of undesirable social conditions; to enable said Corporation to carry out such objects and purposes, it shall have the power to purchase, lease or otherwise acquire real and personal property; to receive gifts and hold the same in trust; to enter into contracts or obligations of any type or kind necessary or proper for the accomplishment of the purposes for which said Corporation is organized, or which shall at any time appear conducive or expedient for the protection or benefit of said Corporation or in the furtherance of its activities.

ARTICLE THREE

The duration of this Corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE FOUR

The principal place of business of this Corporation shall be in the City of
Lewiston, County of Nez Perce, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE FIVE

The Corporation shall have no capital stock, but shall issue membership
certificates to each member thereof, and the rights and interests of all members shall be
equal, with none having the right to acquire a greater interest than the other; all members
are of full legal age and at least two-thirds of such number are citizens of the United States.
