

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF THE
ALAMEDA MINING AND MILLING COMPANY, LIMITED.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, especially under the Act of 1891, approved March 11, 1891, as amendment to Section 2609 of the Revised Statutes of Idaho, Session Laws of 1890 and 1891, pages 172-174. And we hereby certify:

That the name of the said corporation is, THE ALAMEDA MINING AND MILLING COMPANY, LIMITED.

II.

That the object and purposes for which this said corporation is formed are to locate, lay out, secure title to, hold, transfer, develop, and deal in, mining claims, both placer and quartz, of any and all of the precious metals, and to secure title to, hold, transfer, develop, deal in, mill sites; lay out, secure title to, hold, transfer and deal in, ditches and water rights, for milling and mining purposes. Also to acquire, hold and operate any other real estate or personal property necessary to conduct a general milling and mining business for all the precious metals, in all its various forms and phases.

III.

The place where the principal business of said corporation is to be transacted is the City of Stallard County of Shoshone, State of Idaho.

IV.

That the term for which said corporation is to exist is fifty (50) years from and after the date of its incorporation.

V.

That the number of the directors of said corporation shall be five (5) (subject to be changed hereafter) and the names and residences of the directors who are appointed until June 30th 1900, and to serve until the election and qualification of said officers, elected at the election at same date, are as follows, to-wit:


