the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of
Idaho, and to that end do hereby adopt articles of incorporation and
do hereby certify in writing as follows:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation shall be VON-LEE, Incorporated.

ARTICLE II.

The general nature of the business of the corporation and the objects and purposes proposed to be transacted, promoted and carried on by it are as follows:

To carry on the business of mining, milling, concentrating, converting, smelting, treating, preparing for market, buying, selling, exchanging, and otherwise producing and dealing in all kinds of ores, metals and minerals, and the products and by=products thereof of every kind and description and by whatsoever process the same can be or may hereafter be produced, and generally and without limit as to amount, to buy, sell, exchange, lease, acquire and deal in lands, mines and mineral rights and claims, and to conduct all business appertaining thereto; to purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, mining rights, timber rights, mines, buildings, dwellings, plants, machinery, tools and other properties, whatsoever which this corporation may from time to time find to be for its advantage and purposes; to mine and market any mineral or other product that may be found in or on such lands, and to explore, work, exercise, develop

or turn to account the same; to construct and operate transportation facilities for the shipment of the ores or minerals to market; to do all such things as are customarily incident to the carrying on of a general mining business.

To enter into, make, perform, enforce and carry out contracts of every sort and kind with any person, firm, corporation, or association, whether private, public, municipal or body politic, and with the government of the United States or any State or Municipality thereof.

To do all and everything necessary, suitable and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of the powers hereinbefore set forth, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms or individuals, and to do every other act or acts, thing or things incidental or appurtenent to or growing out of, or connected with the aforesaid objects or purposes or any part or parts thereof, provided the same be not inconsistent with the laws under which the corporation is organized, and to do all other things and to have all of the powers and rights that an individual person would have, and to apply surplus earnings or cumulative profits to the purchase or acquisition of its own capital stock, from time to time, and to such extent and in such manner, and upon such terms as its board of directors shall determine.

ARTICLE III.

The principal office and place where the business of said corporation is to be transacted is as follows:
