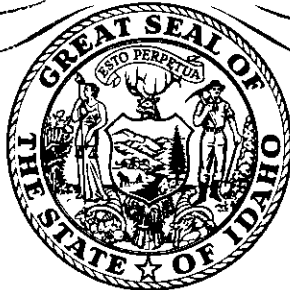

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

CAREY VALLEY ROD & GUN CLUB, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Twenty-eighth** day of **December** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Fifty-nine** and is duly recorded on Film No. **109** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Carey,** in the County of **Blaine,** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CAREY VALLEY ROD & GUN CLUB, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, each being a natural person of full age and a citizen of the United States, and a resident of the State of Idaho, have this day and do hereby associate ourselves together voluntarily for the purpose of forming a non-profit cooperative association under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 10 of Title 30 of the Idaho Code, and to that end we do hereby execute, acknowledge and adopt, in triplicate, the following ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION, namely:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this non-profit corporation is:

"CAREY VALLEY ROD & GUN CLUB, INC."

ARTICLE II.

The purpose and objects for which this association is formed are:

I. To promote, provide for, maintain, operate and conduct an organization for the benefit of the members of the association and to promote, provide for and carry out a program of conservation of the fish and wild-life in the Carey Valley, and the State of Idaho, and promotion of the welfare of the fish and wildlife generally throughout the area, and to foster and encourage a better acquaintence, and closer relationship in regards to all who have interests in and associations with the fish and wild-life population of the State of Idaho, all without pecuniary profit to the association and its members, and in furtherance of those objects and purposes, to buy, lease, take and hold and own, and to mortgage, hypothecate, transfer, exchange, trade or otherwise acquire and dispose of real and personal

property of every kind and nature capable of ownership.

2. To provide for, maintain, and operate club-rooms for the exclusive use of the members of the association and their guests, and to provide for, operate and maintain in connection with such club rooms the conveniences and comforts usually provided for and appurtenant to clubs of this nature; and further to provide facilities of all types and nature for the use of members of the organization to foster and encourage the objects of this association.

3. To enter into contracts and agreements necessary or proper for the furnishing of all facilities for the carrying out of the primary purpose of this organization namely to provide for conservation of fish and wildlife of this state.

4. To have, exercise and enjoy all the powers and privileges now or hereafter granted to non-profit cooperative associations by Chapter 10, Title 30 Idaho Code, and any present or future amendments thereto, and to do any act or thing necessary or convenient or proper for the carrying out of the objects and purposes of a non-profit cooperative association, and carrying into effect any and all of the aforesaid objects and purposes.

5. Upon termination of this incorporation by operation of law, or otherwise, any assets remaining at such time shall be given to the State of Idaho for the use and benefit of the Fish and Game Commission or comparable agency or commission of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III.

The duration of this association shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV.

The location and post-office address of the registered office of this association in the State of Idaho, is Carey, Blaine County, Idaho.

ARTICLE V.

This association shall have no capital stock. Any natural person may become a member of this association, subject to and under the rules and regulations as the Board of Directors and the By-Laws of this association may from time to time establish. All members shall enjoy the same rights and interests and privileges as every other member, and no member can have or acquire a greater interest herein than any other member. Certificates of membership shall be issued to each member of the association, which certificate cannot be assigned so that the transferee thereof can by such transfer become a member of the association, except by resolution of the Board of Directors and under such regulations as the By-laws may prescribe.

ARTICLE VI.

The business of this association shall be managed and conducted by a Board of Directors consisting of six persons who shall be elected annually as and when provided for by the By-laws, and by such executive officers as may be elected by said Board of Directors, to carry on said business under and by virtue of any by-laws which may from time to time be adopted by this association.

ARTICLE VII.

The first Board of Directors of this association shall consist of the following persons who shall serve until the Second Tuesday in December 1960, and until their successors are duly elected and qualified, whose names and post-office addresses are as follows:

ARTICLE VIII.

The By-laws of this association may be amended or repealed and new by-laws adopted at any time, by two-thirds affir-

mative vote of members present at regular meeting or any special meeting called for the purpose of amending such by-laws, provided, however that a quorum as specified in the by-laws or the laws of the State of Idaho are present.
